

SYNOPSIS  
REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF  
BLAINE COUNTY SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 61  
TUESDAY, APRIL 8, 2008, 6:30 P.M.,  
DISTRICT OFFICE

Action was taken to convene to Closed Executive Session pursuant to Idaho Code §67-2345(1)(c) for the discussion of property and pursuant to Idaho Code §67-2345(1)(b) to conduct a formal Expulsion Hearing for a Blaine County School District student and for the discussion of personnel.

**I. Closed Executive Session**

The Board of Trustees discussed a property issue with Ms. Cindy Ward, Realtor from Cornerstone Realty.

Thereafter, action was taken to return to Regular Open Session.

**II. Return To Regular Open Session**

Action was taken to direct the Superintendent, Assistant Superintendent, and Business Manager to negotiate a firm purchase price not to exceed \$725,000.00 to purchase the property directly west of the District Office known as Lot 10-A of Parkview Estates, Hailey, Blaine County, Idaho, provided the Seller executes an agreement to not take any action to oppose the rezone of the property.

Action was then taken to return to Closed Executive Session pursuant to Idaho Code §67-2345(1)(b) to conduct a formal Expulsion Hearing for a Blaine County School District student and for the discussion of personnel.

**III. Return To Closed Executive Session**

The Board of Trustees conducted a formal Expulsion Hearing for a Blaine County School District student.

The Board of Trustees heard testimony from the school administrator.

The Board of Trustees then heard testimony from the student and his father and mother.

The Board then excused the parties so they could deliberate.

Thereafter, action was taken to return to Regular Open Session.

#### **IV. Return To Open Session**

Due to extenuating circumstances and the lack of a complete information packet, action was taken not to expel Student No. 2007-08:9 and the student was directed to immediately return to Wood River High School.

Thereafter, action was taken to return to Closed Executive Session pursuant to Idaho Code §67-2345(1)(b) for the discussion of personnel.

#### **V. Return To Closed Executive Session**

The Board of Trustees discussed personnel issues.

Thereafter, action was taken to return to Regular Open Session.

#### **VI. Return To Regular Open Session**

No action was taken as a result of the discussion of personnel held in Closed Executive Session.

#### **VII. Call To Order And Welcome**

Chairman Alexandra Sundali called the Regular April meeting of the Board of Trustees of Blaine County School District No. 61 to order at 6:50 p.m. and welcomed everyone in attendance.

Present were Vice Chairman Julie Dahlgren and Board Members Kim Nilsen, Mari Beth Matthews, and Dan Parke. Also in attendance were Assistant Superintendent/Chief Academic Officer, Lonnie Barber; Director of Curriculum/Dual Language Learners, Matt Murray; School District Treasurer, Mike Chatterton; and Board Clerk, Cathy Zaccardi. Superintendent of Schools, Jim Lewis, was absent from the meeting.

Chairman Sundali stated that a quorum was present.

Dr. Barber stated that Blake Walsh requested that the Wood River High School and Wood River Middle School Administrators, along with Michel Sewell and Jill Clark, GATE Facilitators in their respective buildings, receive an accolade for their productive work in re-establishing healthy GATE programs at each school.

Dr. Barber then stated that last year, Fritz Peters allowed his GATE Facilitator, Jill Clark, to have a free period specifically for the purpose of making individual contact with GATE students and their parents. This move was so successful that John Blackman followed suit this year at the high school, giving Michel Sewell a free period for the same purpose.

Dr. Barber then stated that Blake commended the administration for responding to the need presented to them by the GATE Committee and the facilitators are to be commended for their work in demonstrating how significantly the program can be improved by productive use of this extra time.

**c. Marilyn Rountree, Bellevue Elementary School Music Teacher; And Paula Schwab, Hailey Elementary School Music Teacher**

Dr. Barber then stated that Marilyn and Paula each offer an extracurricular Music offering to students in their schools. Even though they teach at two different schools in the District, they combined their elective choirs to present at this Music Festival. Both teachers had their students rehearse separately, and after one combined rehearsal, they set off together to be judged.

Dr. Barber then stated that this collaborative project inspired the students! They learned the value of hard work and commitment through dedicated practice. Performing in front of judges is the ultimate assessment of whether or not students attain mastery in their learning.

Their partnership serves as a great example of networking students and resources around a common vision in our School District, and he congratulated Marilyn and Paula for a job well done

**d. Blaine County School District And Vice Chairman Julie Dahlgren**

Dr. Barber stated that a panel of judges selected Vice Chairman Julie Dahlgren's program, *Pre-Kindergarten*, to receive honorable mention in the under 5,000 enrollment category in the Magna Awards 2008 recognition program. In addition, Blaine County School District will also be recognized at the American School Board Journal's luncheon for school leaders during the NSBA Annual Conference in Orlando, Florida.

Dr. Barber then stated that the editors and the selection panel were impressed with the quality of the entries they received. All of the programs receiving an award or honorable mention are a credit to American education. Our project was one of only fifteen selected by the judges for special recognition.

**XII. Guest Presentations – Information/Action**

**a. Wood River High School Student Leadership Report**

The Wood River High School Student Leadership Team, comprised of Kassie Ayala, Dakota Barnes, and Ashleigh Share, presented to the School Board Trustees the highlights of their school. Their report included a report on unique courses, senior projects, AP/honors/dual credit offerings, the Academies, Music, Debate, sports, clubs, community service, special offerings, travels, the Wood River High School Student Union, its mission, vision, and motto, its values, committees, celebrations and recognitions, community outreach, diversity initiatives, service committee, social issues, awareness (local, national, and global), donkey basketball, Special Olympics 2009, membership, public relations, student comments, and concluded with, “With Unity NO Vision Is Too Grand.”

The Board thanked the students for a very informative and upbeat report.

**b. Application For Study/Travel By Student Group – Geraldine Maniere And Stephanie Spindler, Wood River High School Media Specialist And English Teachers, Respectively**

Action was taken to approve the Application For Study/Travel By Student Group submitted by Geraldine Maniere, Wood River High School Media Specialist, and Stephanie Spindler, Wood River High School English teacher, to take approximately four (4) students to Fort Worth, Texas, to attend the National Association Student Council National Conference being held 25-29 June 2008.

**c. Environmental Practices Committee Annual Update – Environmental Practices Committee Members**

Environmental Practices Committee Members reported on the Vending Machine Miser, which saves approximately \$600.00 per year, biodiesel fuel, which will be available in the Wood River Valley in June 2008, the carbon footprint in which we have local government involvement (Hailey, Ketchum, and Blaine County) to complete a carbon assessment, the Wood River High School Environmental Club and its activities, recycling efforts, recycled paper, and new schools and LEED certification (Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design), which is a third party certification process. They have found that LEED buildings improve student performance, reduce absenteeism, and reduce energy costs.

Chairman Sundali thanked the committee members for their report.

**XIII. Curriculum Report – Matt Murray, Director Of Curriculum/Dual Language Learners**

**a. Curriculum Highlights**

Mr. Matt Murray, Director of Curriculum/Dual Language Learners, stated that the District is writing and adopting curriculum this year in the areas of Language Arts, World Languages, P.E., and Health, and those curricula will be coming to the Board over the next few months.
