SPECIAL MEETING OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF
BLAINE COUNTY SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 61
FRIDAY, NOVEMBER 4, 2011 – 12:00 P.M.

Board Member Kathryn Graves made a motion to convene to Closed Executive Session pursuant to Idaho Code §67-2345(1)(b) to conduct a Re-enrollment Hearing for a Blaine County School District student. The motion was seconded by Paul Bates and passed unanimously by roll call vote.

Present were Board Chair Steve Guthrie and Board Members, Paul Bates and Kathryn Graves. Also in attendance were Wood River High School Principal, Peter Jurovich and Board Clerk, Laurie Kaufman.

Board Chair Steve Guthrie stated that a quorum was present.

I. Closed Executive Session

The Executive Session for the purpose of conducting a Re-enrollment Hearing commenced at 12:00 p.m. in the Blaine County School District Office located at 118 West Bullion St, Hailey, Blaine County, Idaho, to determine whether or not the re-enrollment of Student No. 2010-2011:09 should be approved by the Board of Trustees of Blaine County School District No. 61.

Mr. Jurovich then declared that he was the duly appointed Hearing Officer for the purposes of administering the hearing.

Present at the hearing on behalf of the Administrative Staff were Principal, Fritz Peters and teachers, Janet Dennis and Tod Gunter.

Present on behalf of the student was the student's father and grandfather.

The Hearing Officer verified with both parties that they had received a copy of the Notice of Hearing, which set forth the charges, location, time and date of meeting, and rights of the student as provided by statute.

Thereafter, upon conclusion of opening remarks, the Administrative Staff presented its evidence.

Following the Administrative Staff's presentation of evidence, the student presented his evidence.

The Hearing Officer then allowed both the Administrative Staff and the student to give closing remarks and excused the parties so the Board would deliberate and make a decision.

II. Convene to Open Session

After a full and complete deliberation and being fully advised in the premises, Board Member Paul Bates made a motion to convene to Open Session. The motion was seconded by Kathryn Graves and passed unanimously by roll call vote.

Board Member Steve Guthrie made a motion by stating: The Board of Trustees hereby renders its decision to re-enroll Student No. 2010-2011:09 in Blaine County School District on November 7, 2011 under certain conditions.

The Student will be under a Student Behavior Contract and shall include, but not limited to, the following:

- 1) Will comply with Blaine County School District attendance policies;
- 2) A good faith effort to do well in all classes;
- 3) No intimidation or harassment of students or staff, including cyber bullying on or off campus;
- 4) No consumption or possession of tobacco, drugs, alcohol, or other prohibited/illegal substances;
- 5) No vandalism;
- 6) Be respectful of other students and staff members;
- 7) Must comply with all current and future Blaine County School District rules, regulations, and policies; and
- 8) The Board expects compliance with the Behavioral Contract.
- 9) If the Behavioral Contract is violated, Student will immediately go before the Board of Trustees in a formal Expulsion Hearing.
