Dear Parents/Guardians:

South Central Public Health District will be holding a **FREE H1N1 vaccination clinic this Friday from 12:00 PM to 5:00 PM at Hailey Elementary School.** Earlier this fall we sent home letters requesting parents complete and return a form indicating whether or not they wanted their child or children to receive the H1N1 vaccine. **Those who returned the forms will receive first priority at this vaccination clinic.** South Central Public Health District has received enough vaccines to accommodate those who have signed up, including siblings ages 2-18.

A parent or guardian is required to be present when their child is vaccinated. If you have children attending more than one school, all of them may receive the vaccination at this clinic. Everyone seeking a vaccination at the clinic will need a completed and signed consent form. While the forms will be available at the clinic location, you can get a jump start by downloading the form from the SCPHD website, (www.phd5.idaho.gov) by clicking on the “H1N1 info for parents” button.

In order to prevent overcrowding and congestion, we are suggesting that the following schedule be used. If you have children that attend more than one school, they may be brought in together for vaccinations. Children of area preschools are also welcome to be brought into the clinic at anytime during its operation.

Bellevue / Woodside Elementary	1:15 pm – 2:45 pm
Hemingway Elementary	2:30 pm – 3:30 pm
WR Middle School	3:00 pm – 5:00 pm
WR High School	3:00 pm – 5:00 pm
Community School	3:00 pm – 5:00 pm
