| Responsibilities of School District Officials | Policy Number 702.1 |

The Board of Trustees for any school district is authorized to provide for the transportation of pupils to and from the public schools of that district and is made responsible for the operation of any transportation system established. The local Board is empowered to adopt such policies and regulations, not inconsistent with the law and with regulations adopted by the State Board of Education, as are necessary to meet those responsibilities attendant to the operation of an efficient transportation system. The following list includes many (but not all) of the responsibilities which a Board of Trustees and designated school officials must assume:

- (1) provide a system of transportation,
- (2) purchase school buses,
- (3) contract for transportation,
- (4) employ school bus drivers,
- (5) provide liability insurance,
- (6) stress safety practices.
