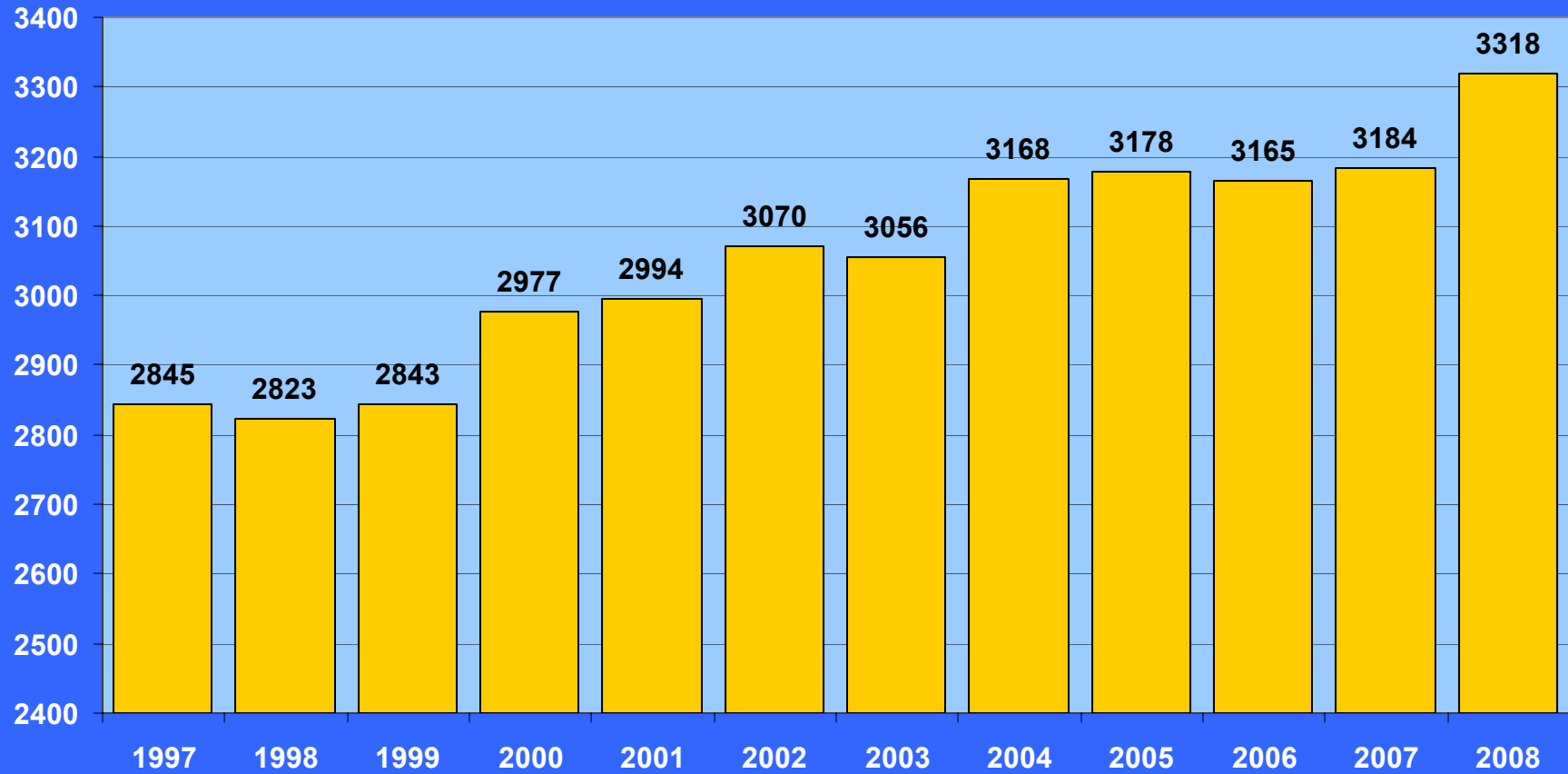

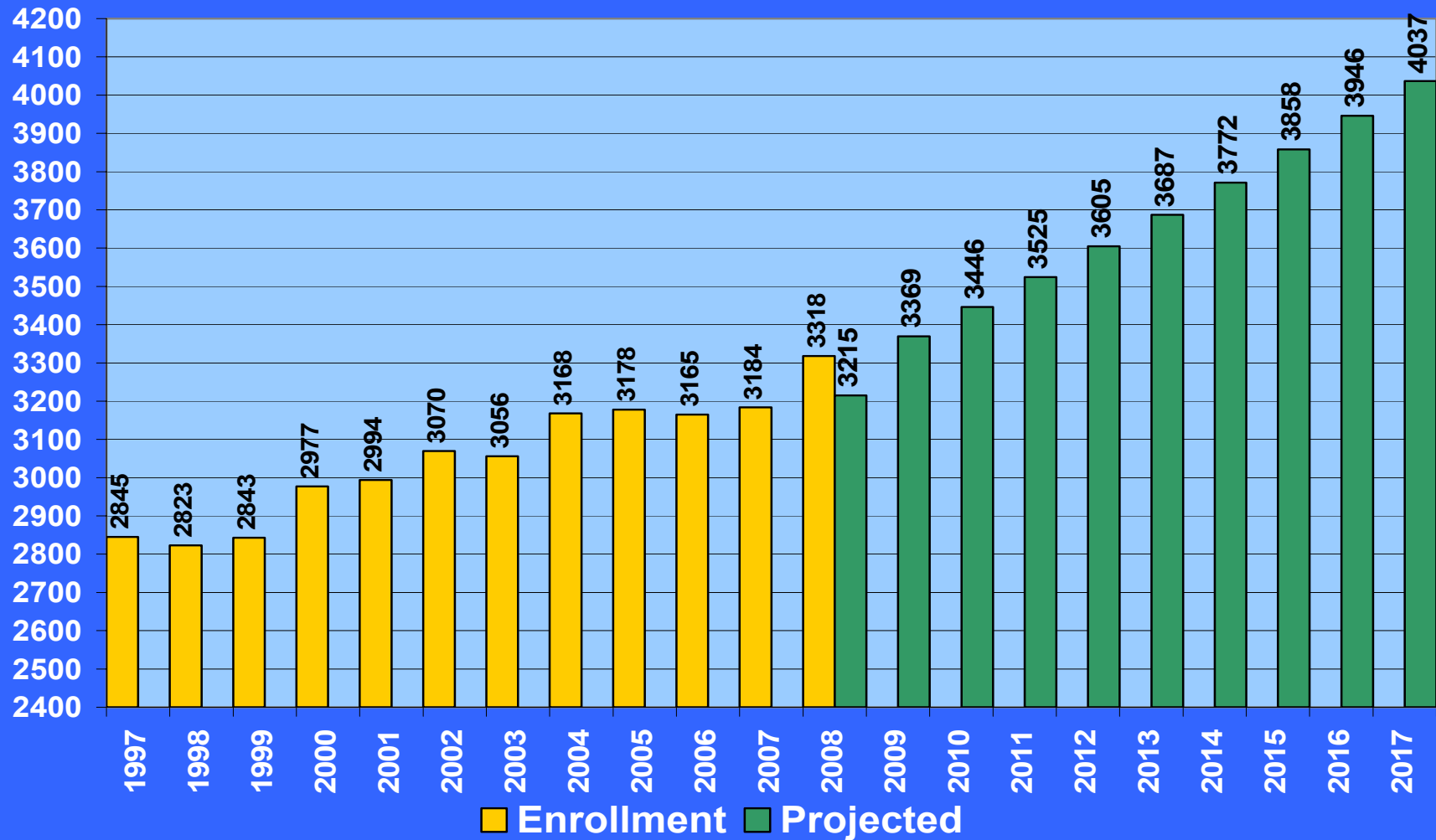

## Total Students



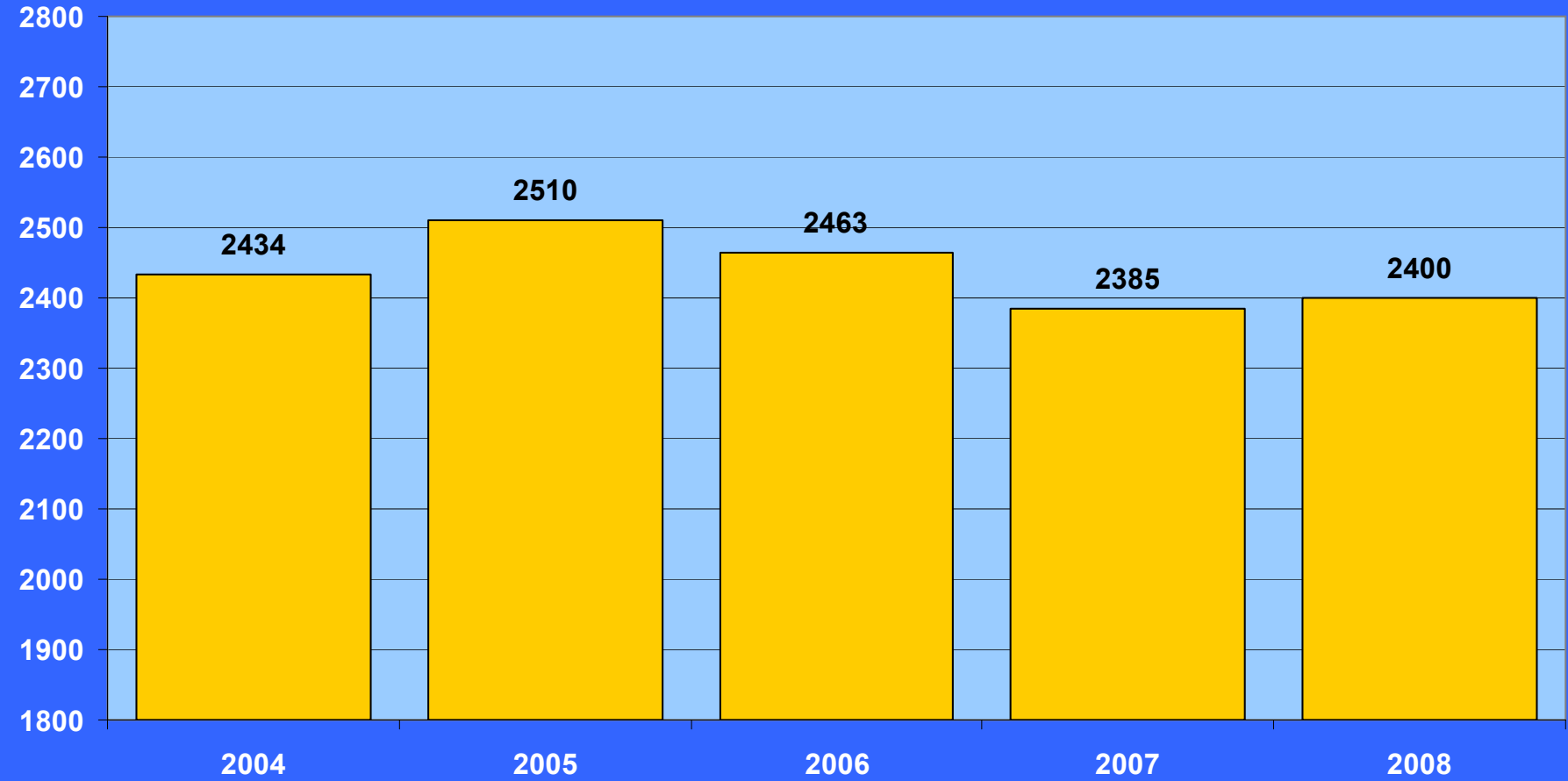

## Total Students Enrollment History and Projected



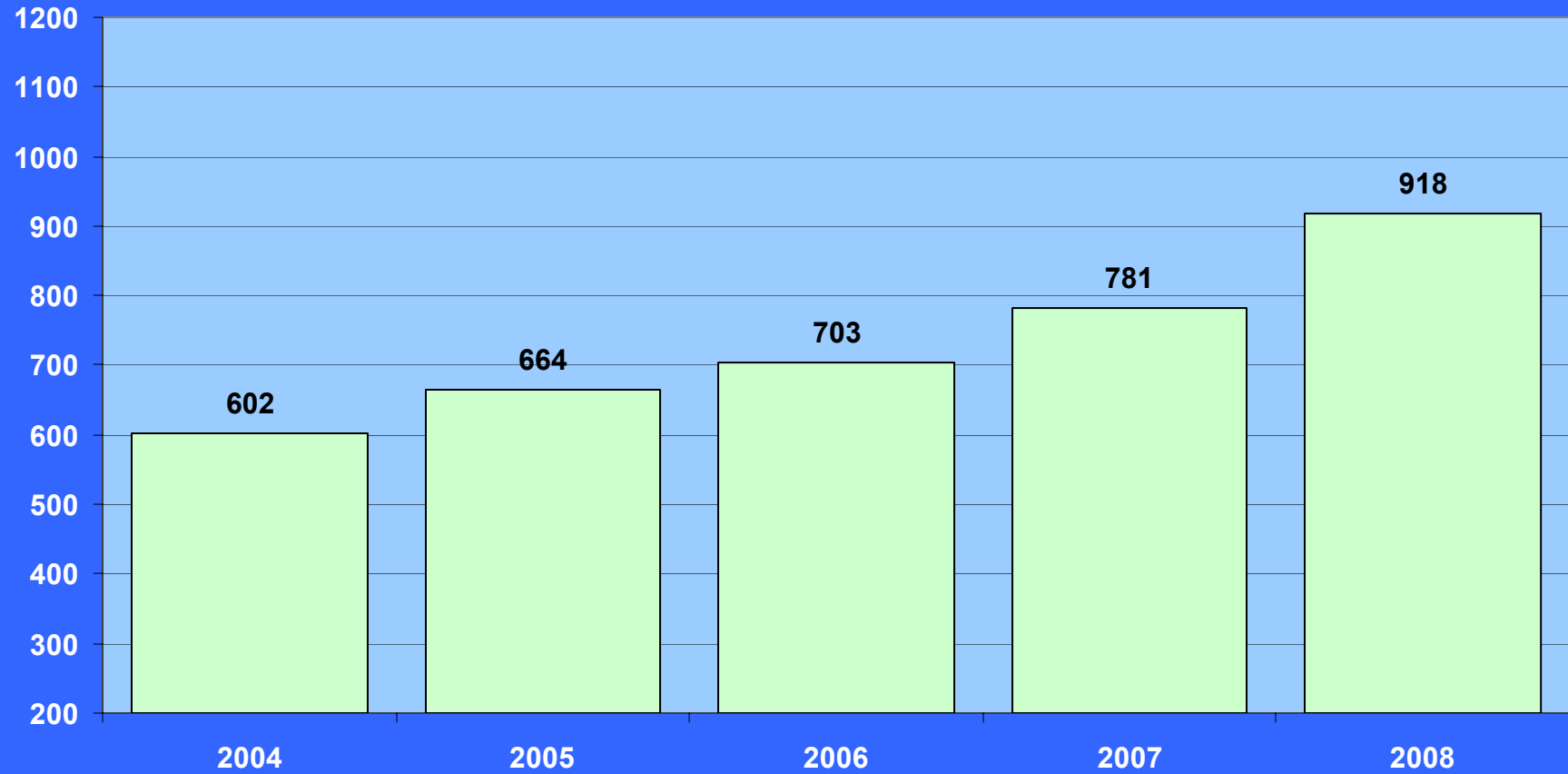

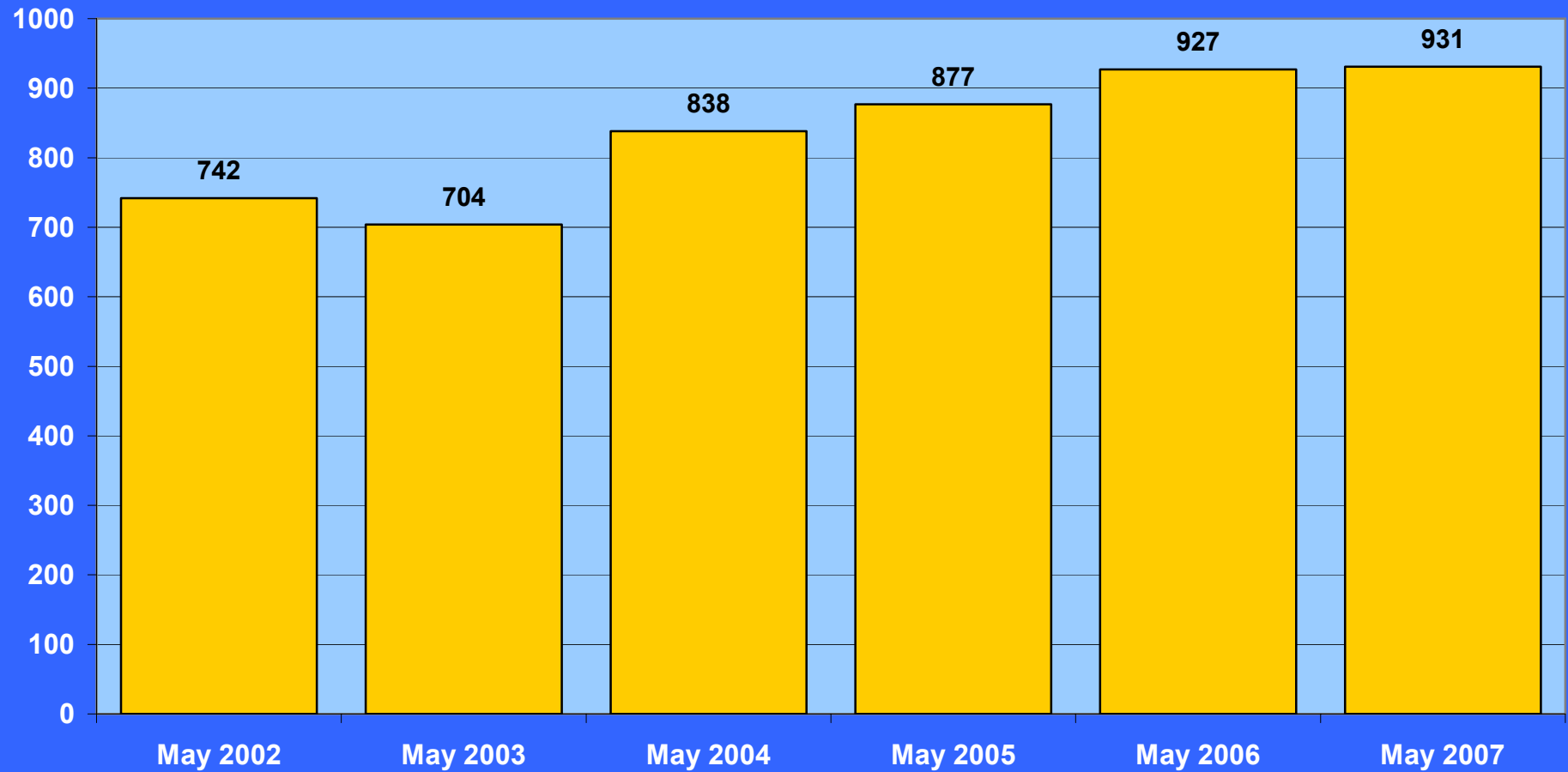

## Hispanic Students



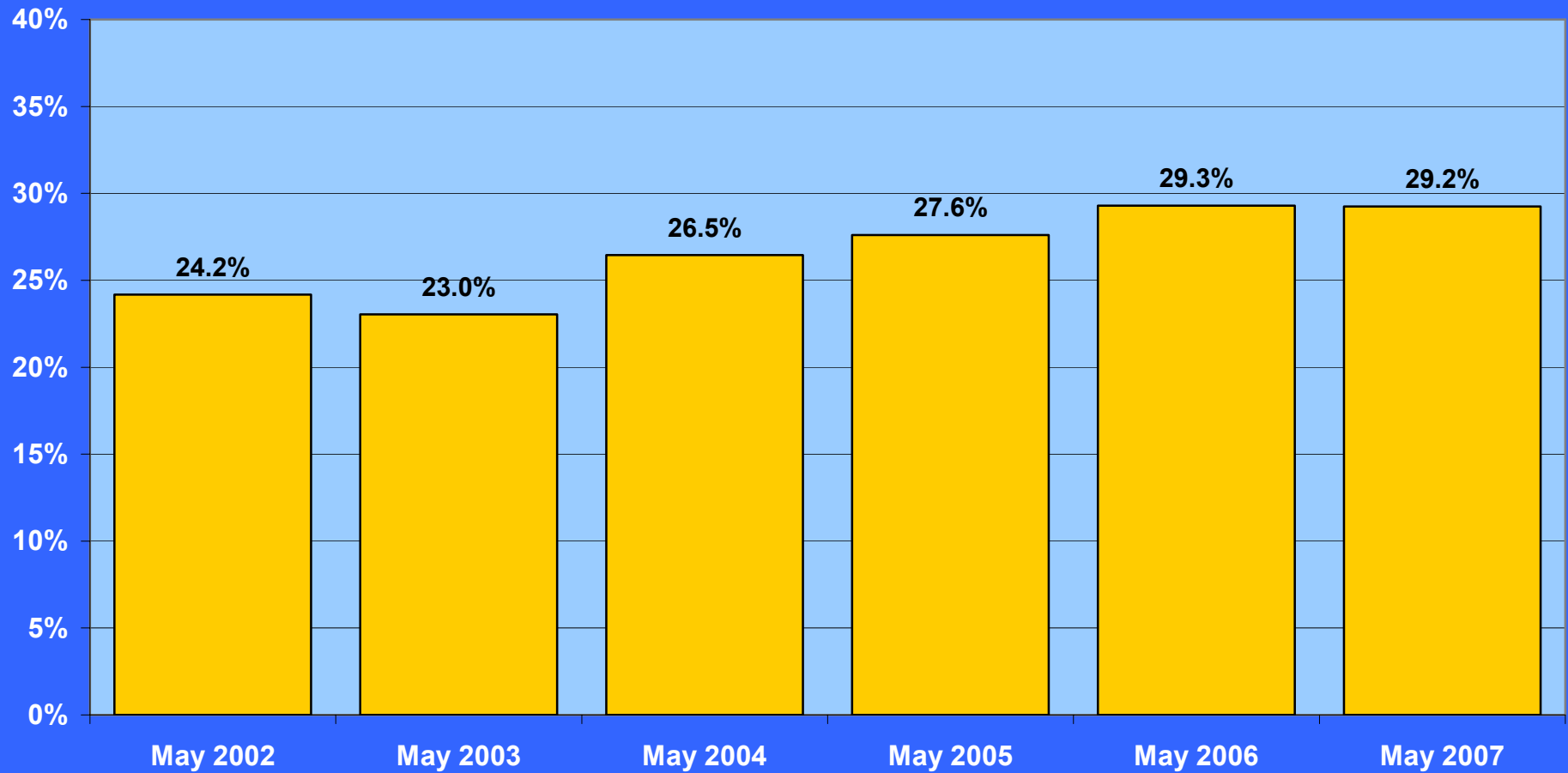

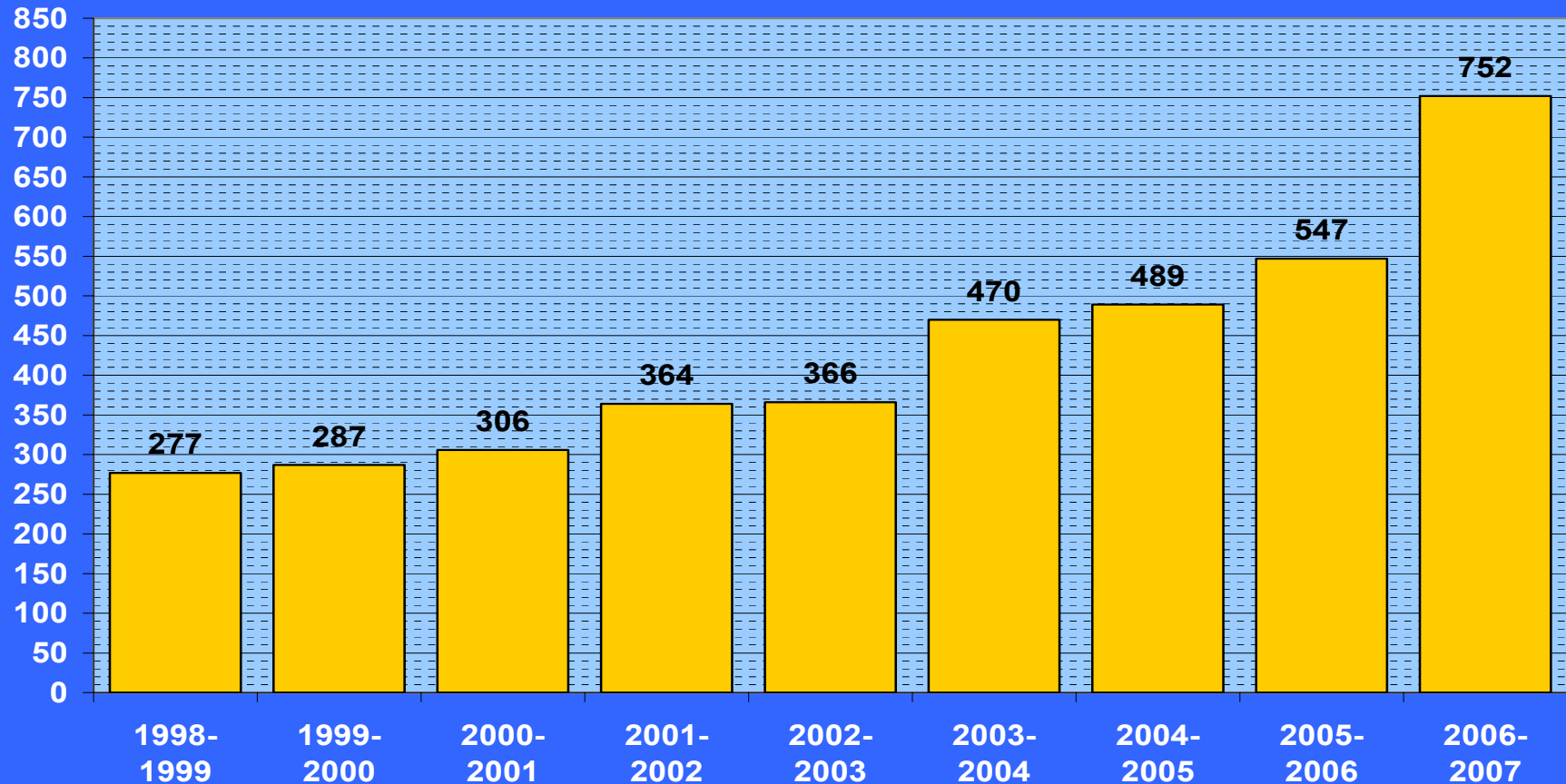
## Economically Disadvantaged Students Percentage

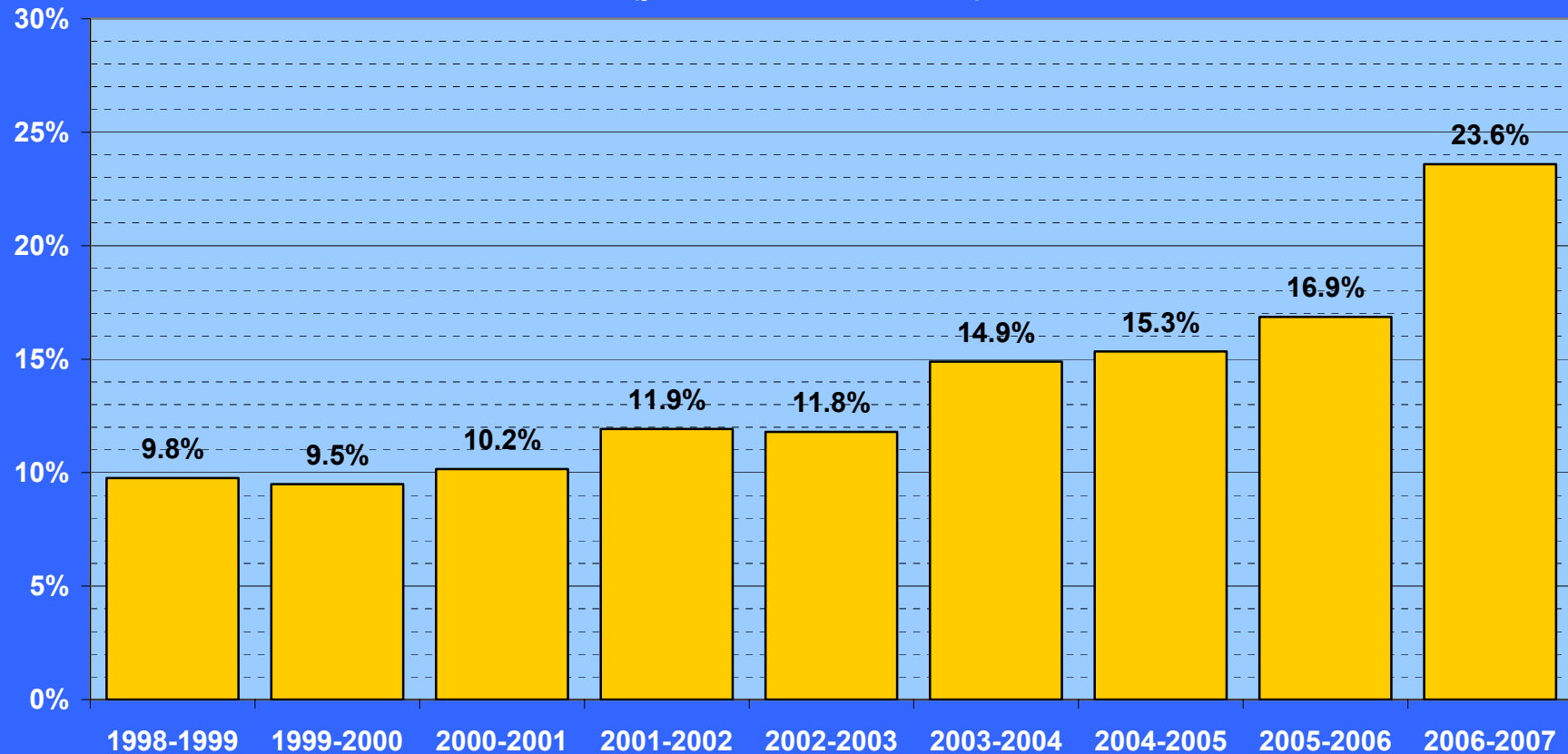

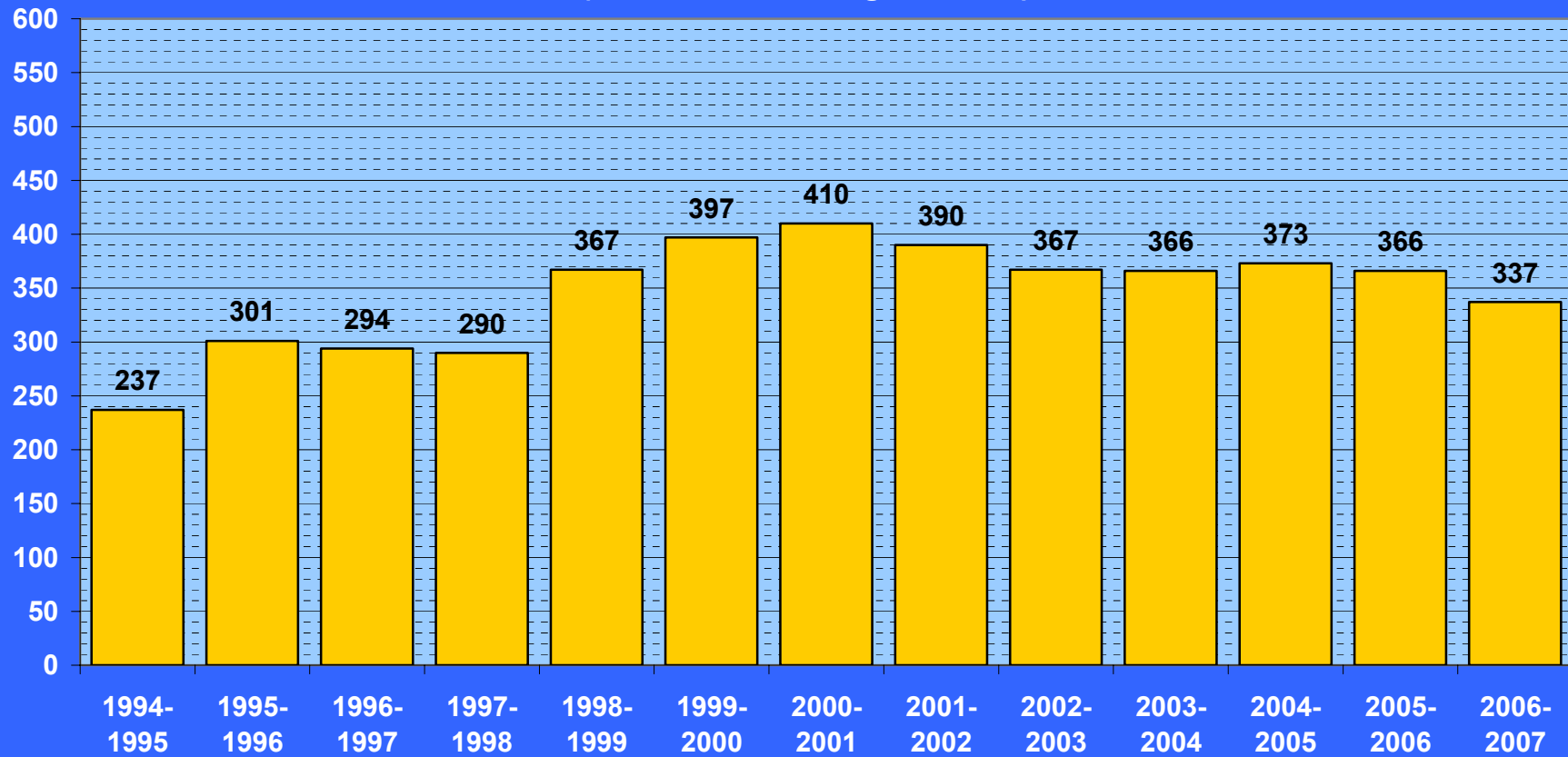

## Limited English Proficient (LEP) (percent of enrollment)



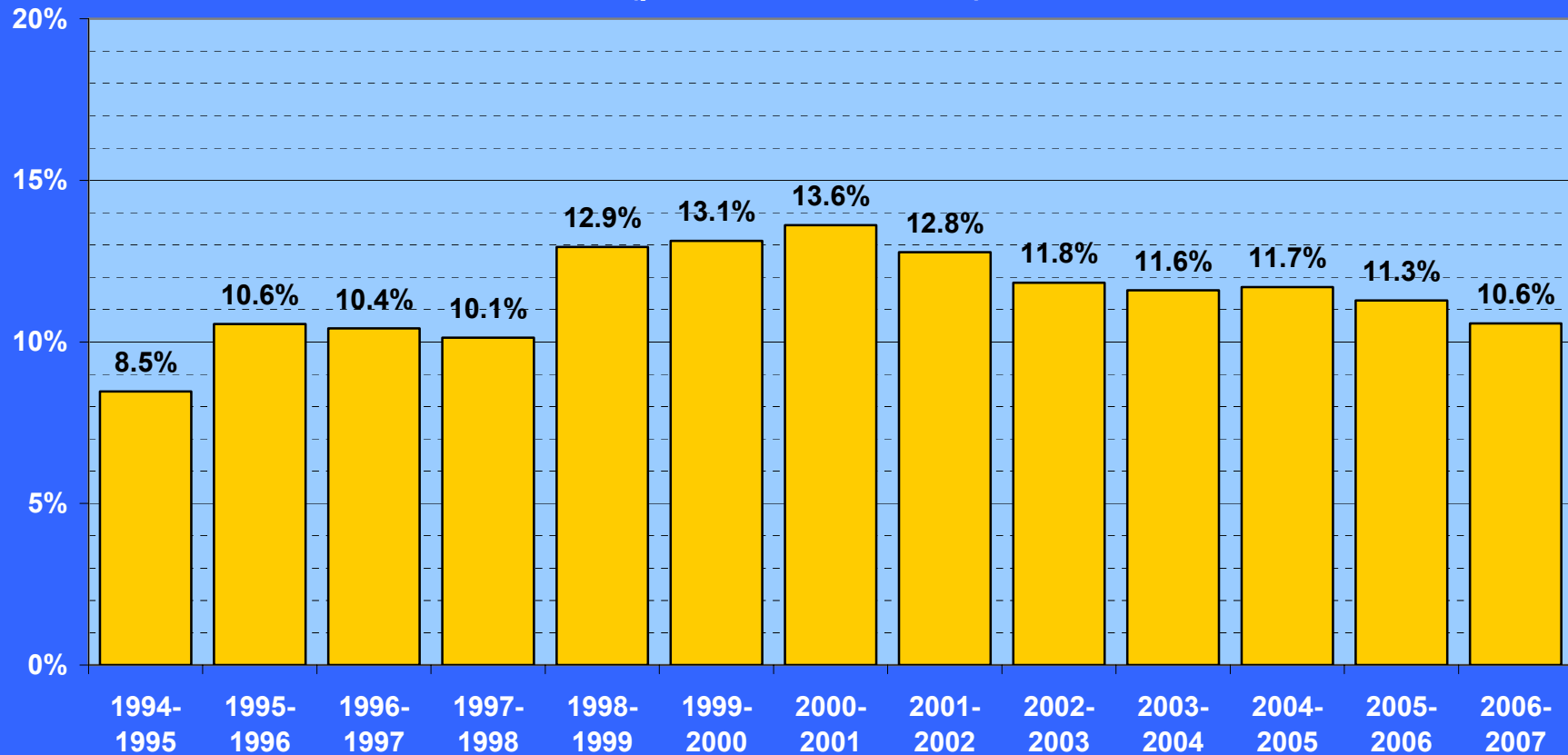

## Special Education (students receiving services)



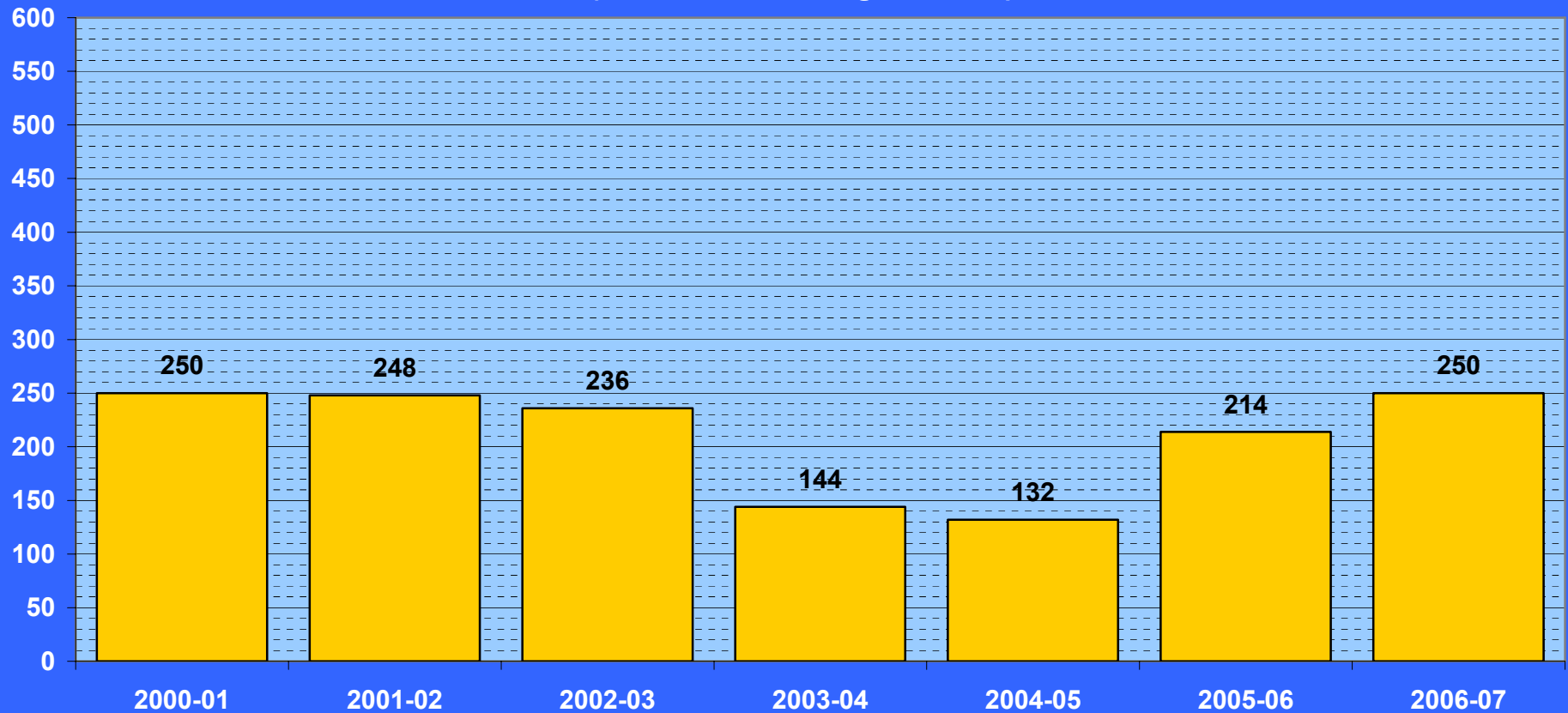

## Special Education (percent of enrollment)



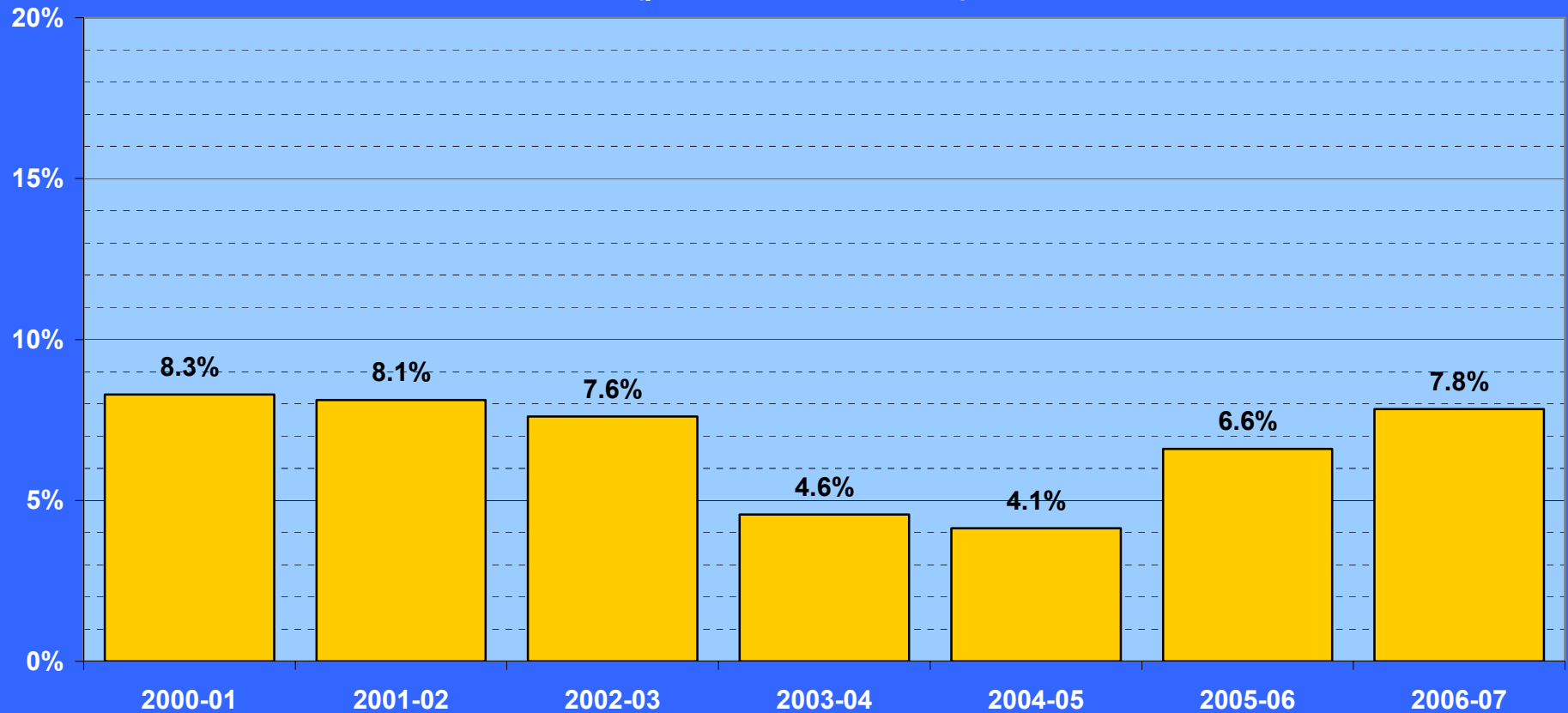

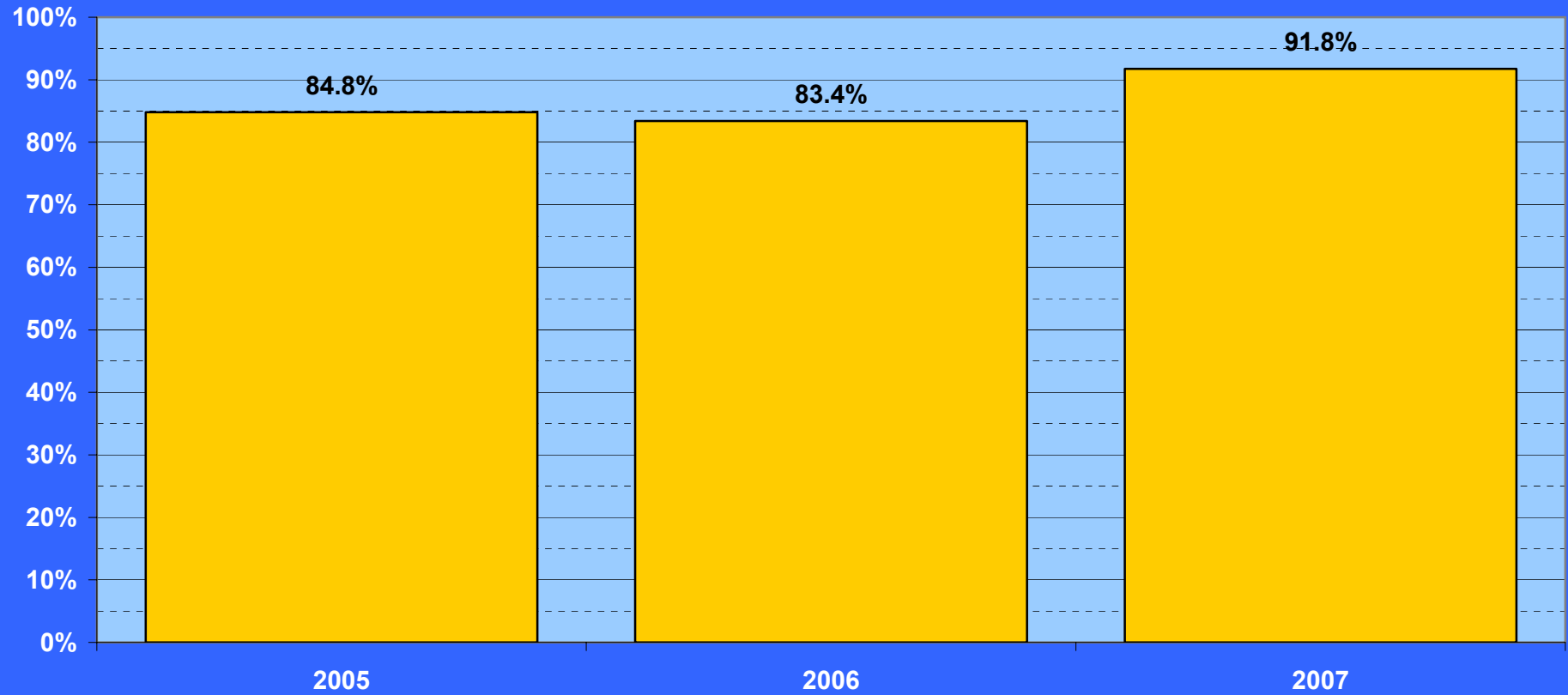
## Gifted and Talented (GATE) (percent of enrollment)

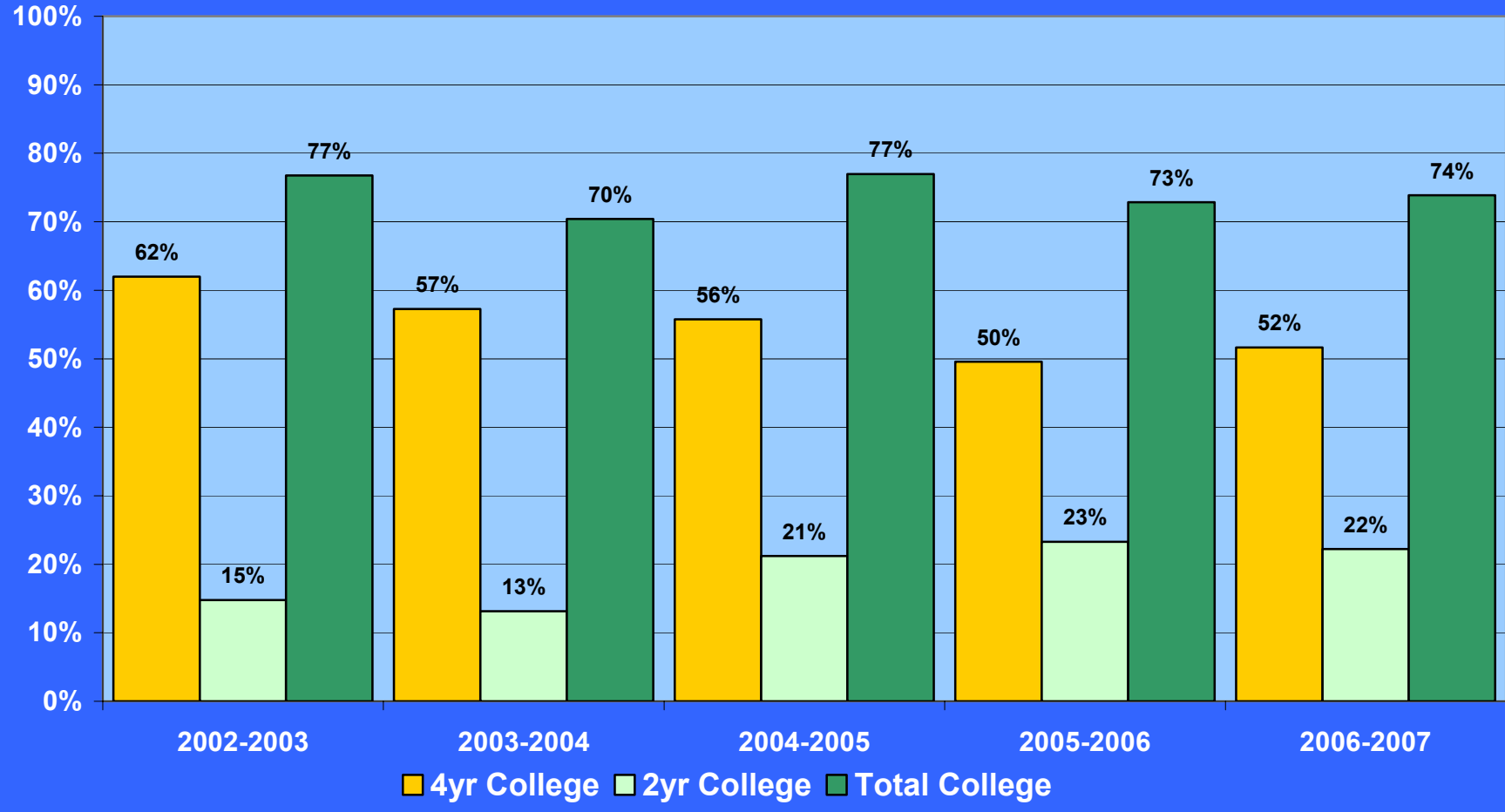

## District Graduation Rate



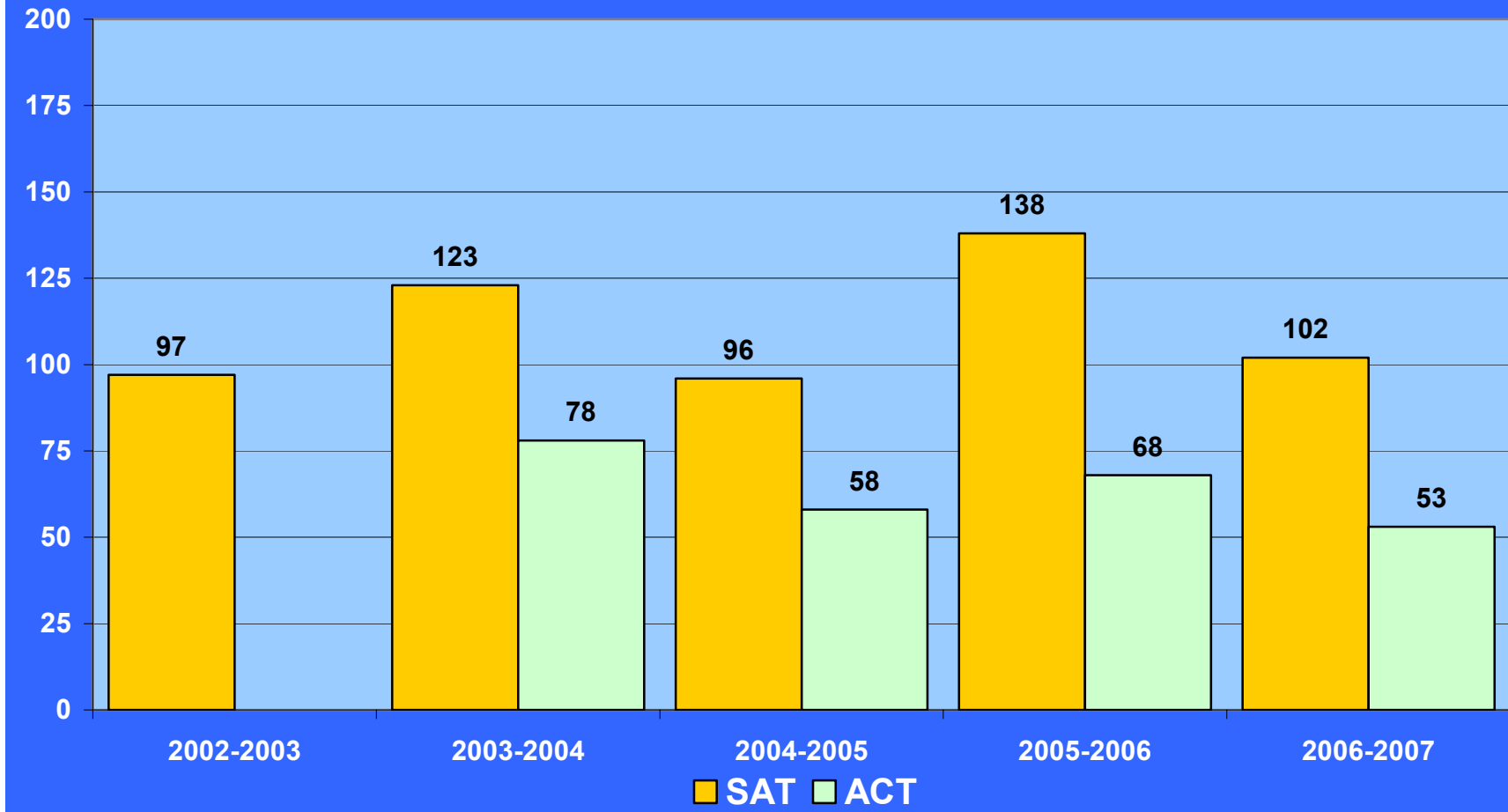

### District Graduates Leaving for College



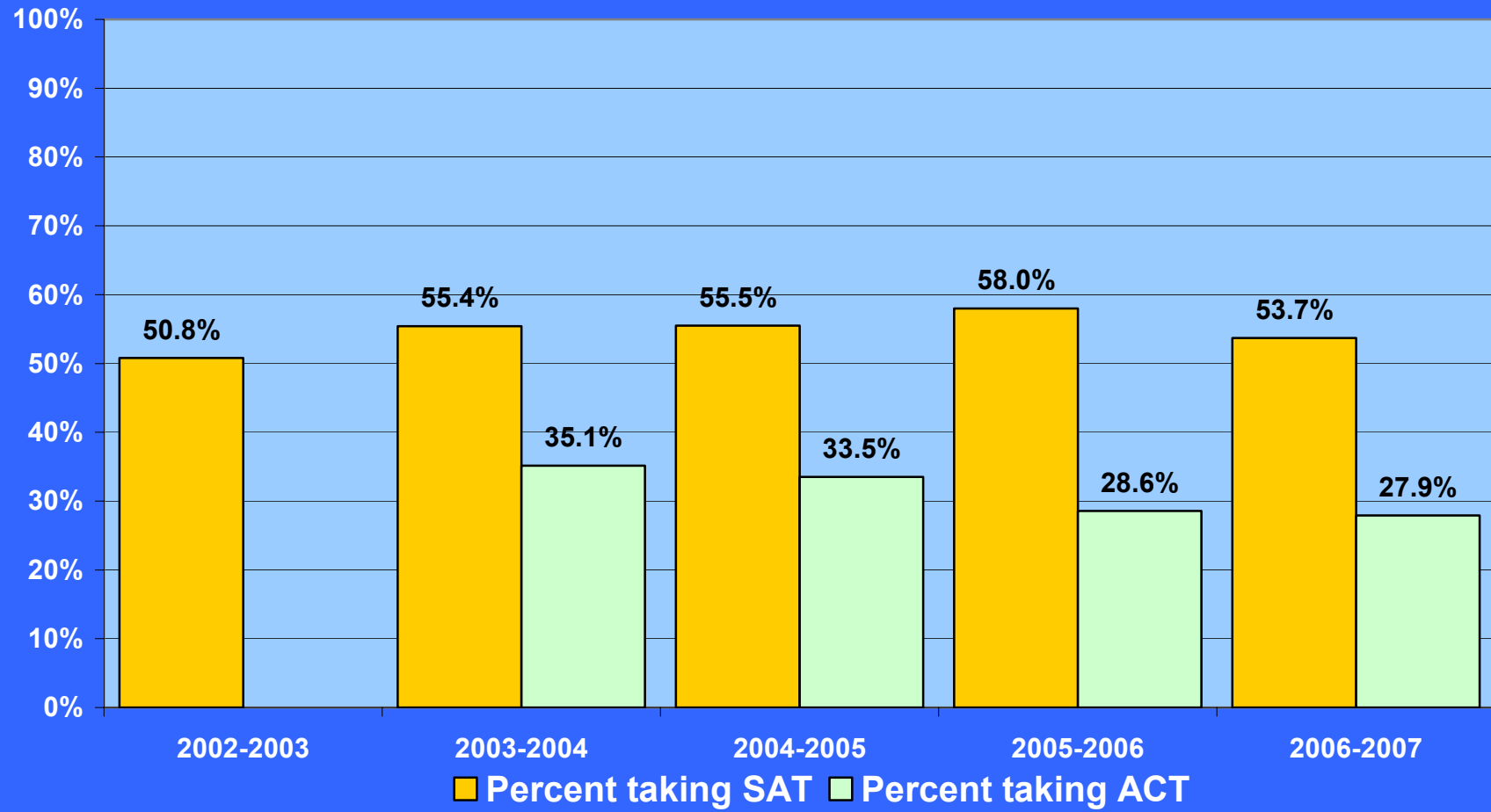

## Graduates Who Took the SAT and/or ACT



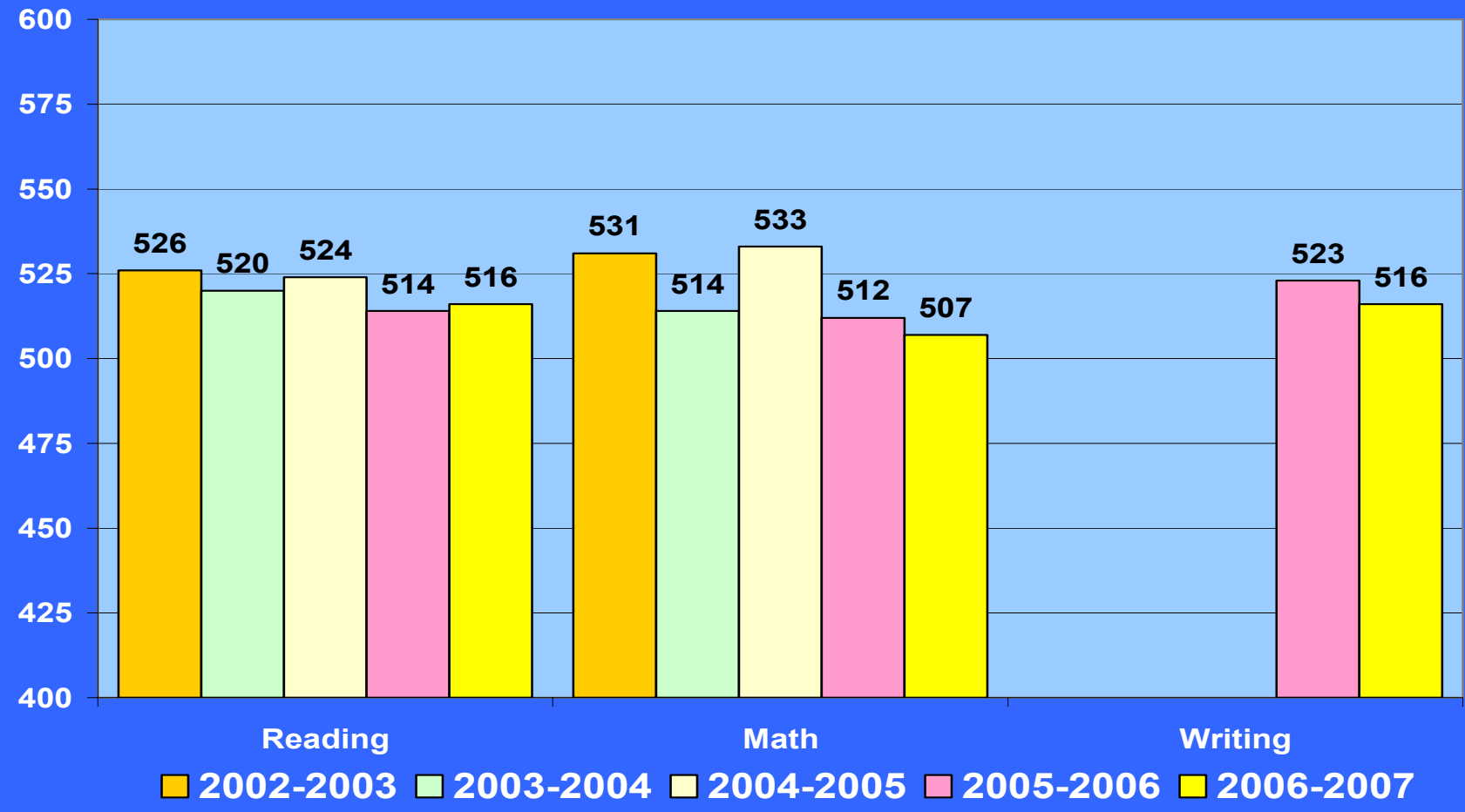

## Percent of Seniors Taking the SAT and/or ACT



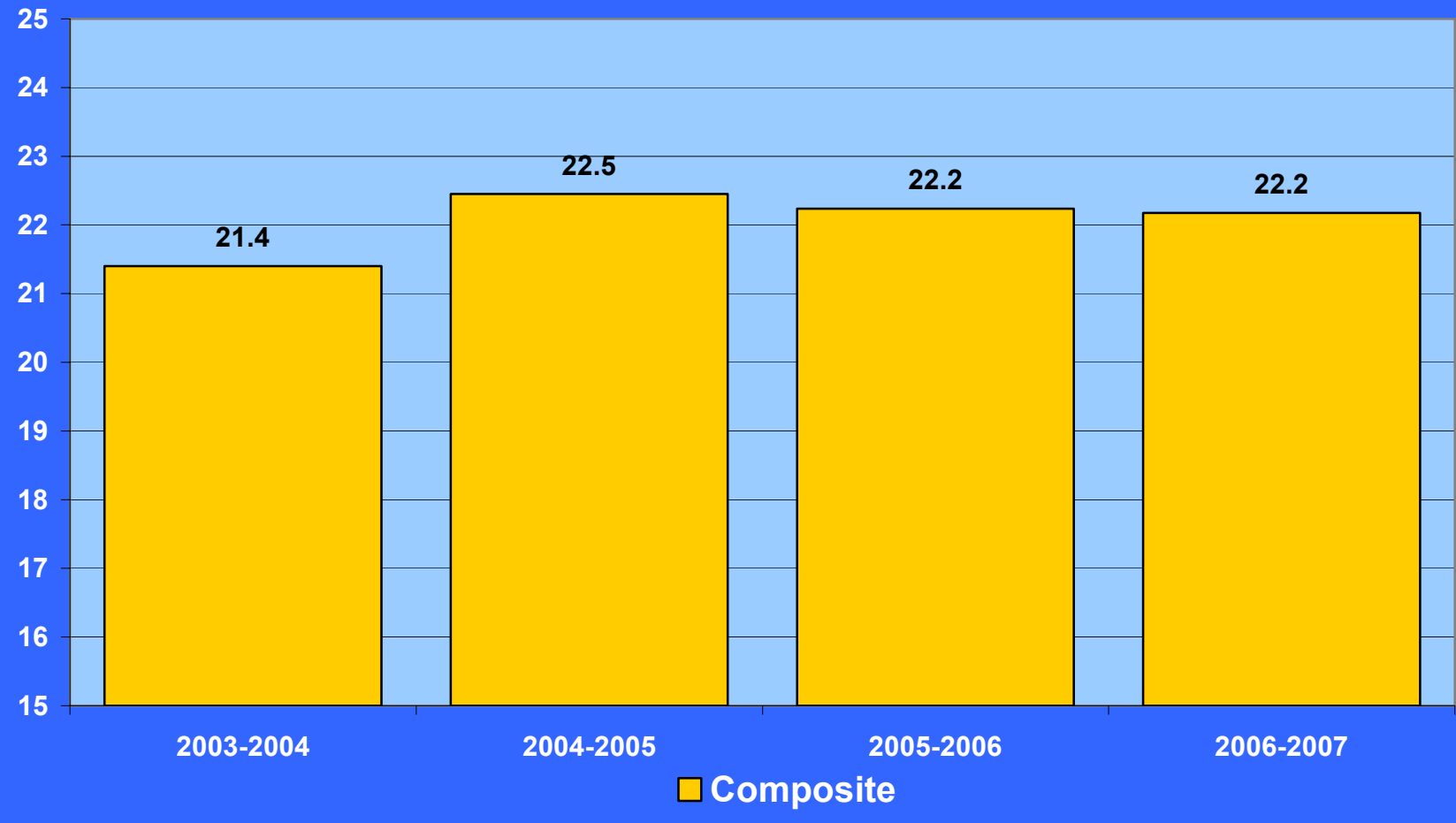

# Average SAT Scores



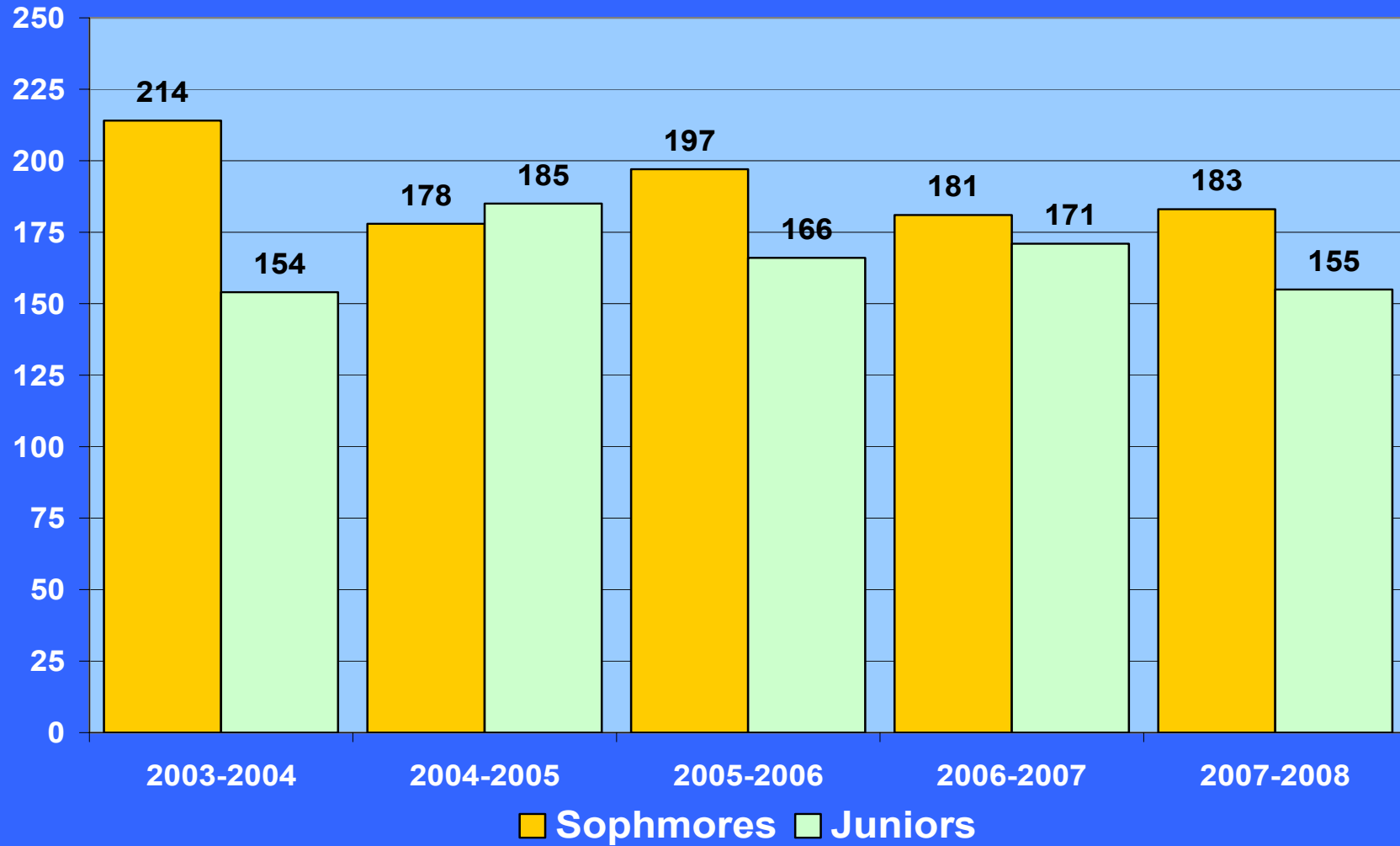

# Average ACT Scores



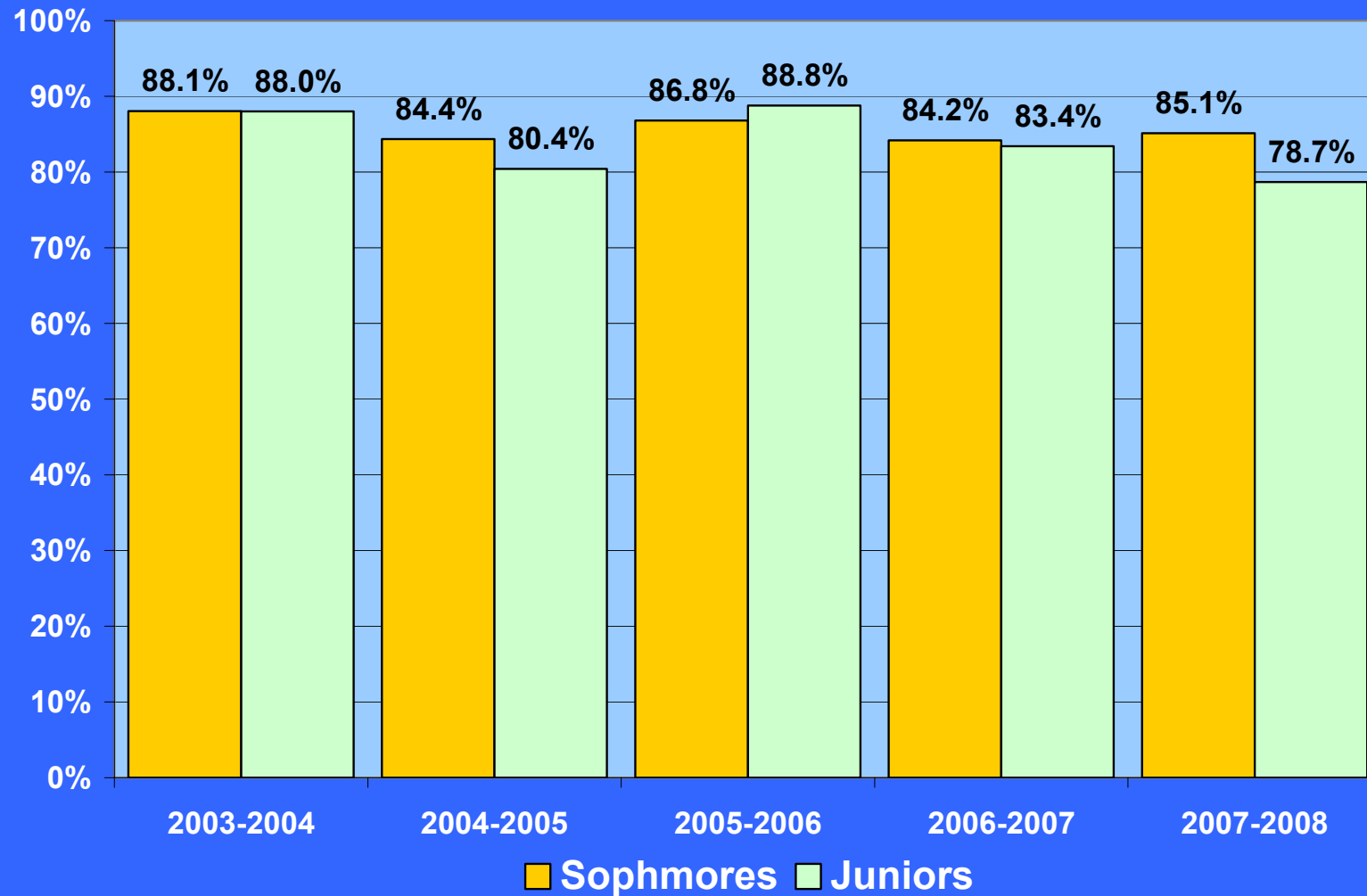

## WRHS Students Taking the PSAT



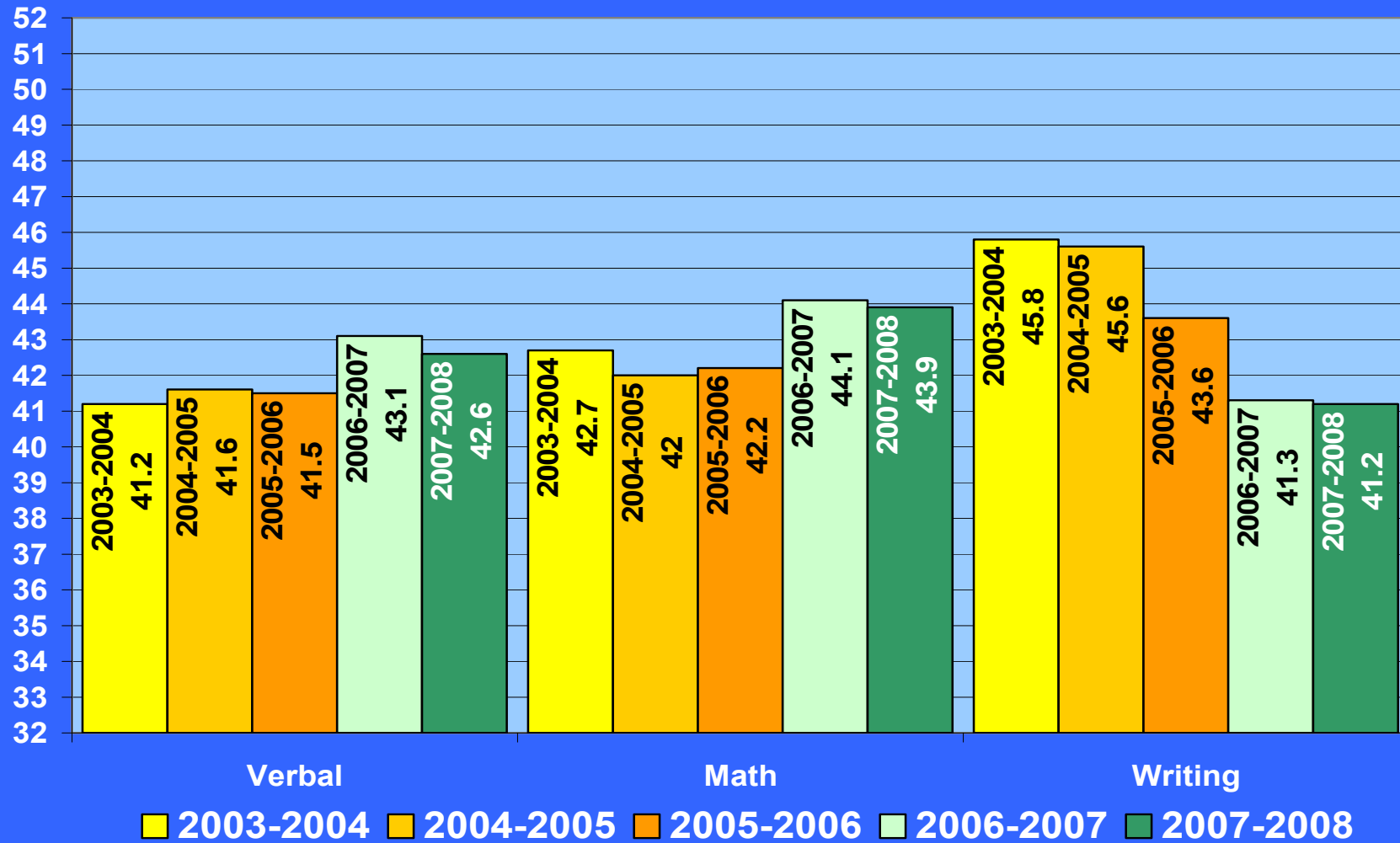

## Percent of WRHS Students Taking the PSAT



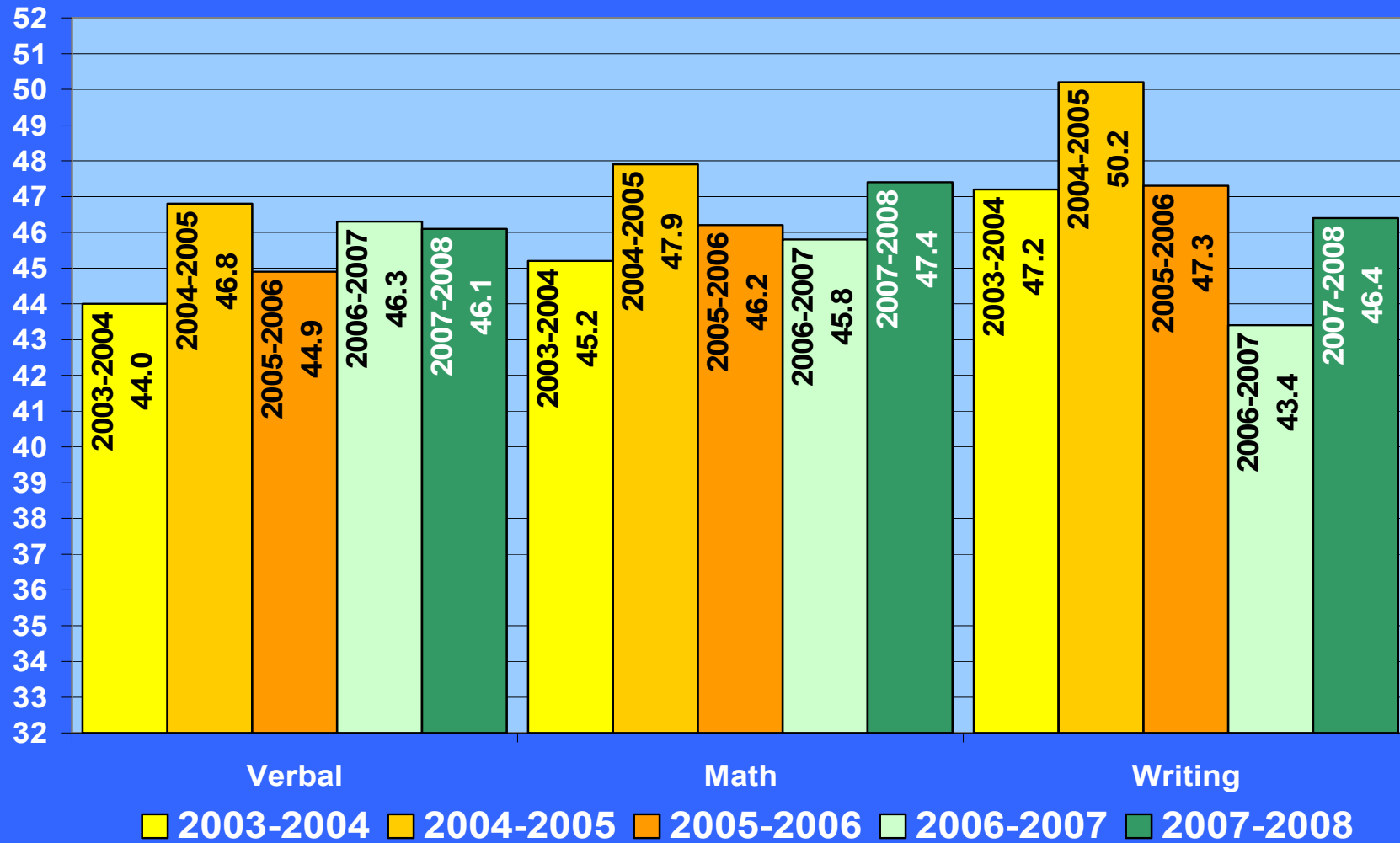

## Sophomore WRHS Average PSAT Scores



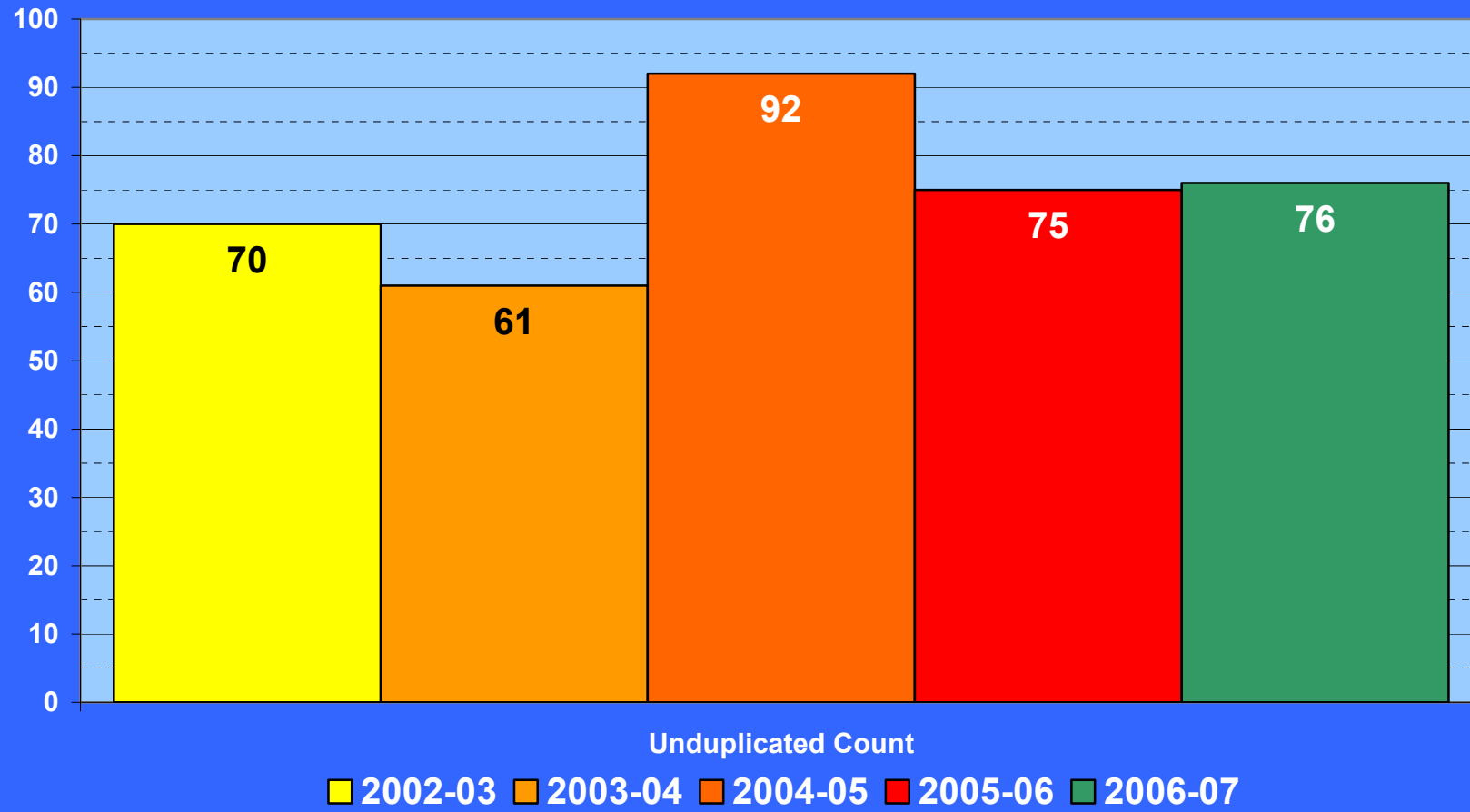

## Junior WRHS Average PSAT Scores



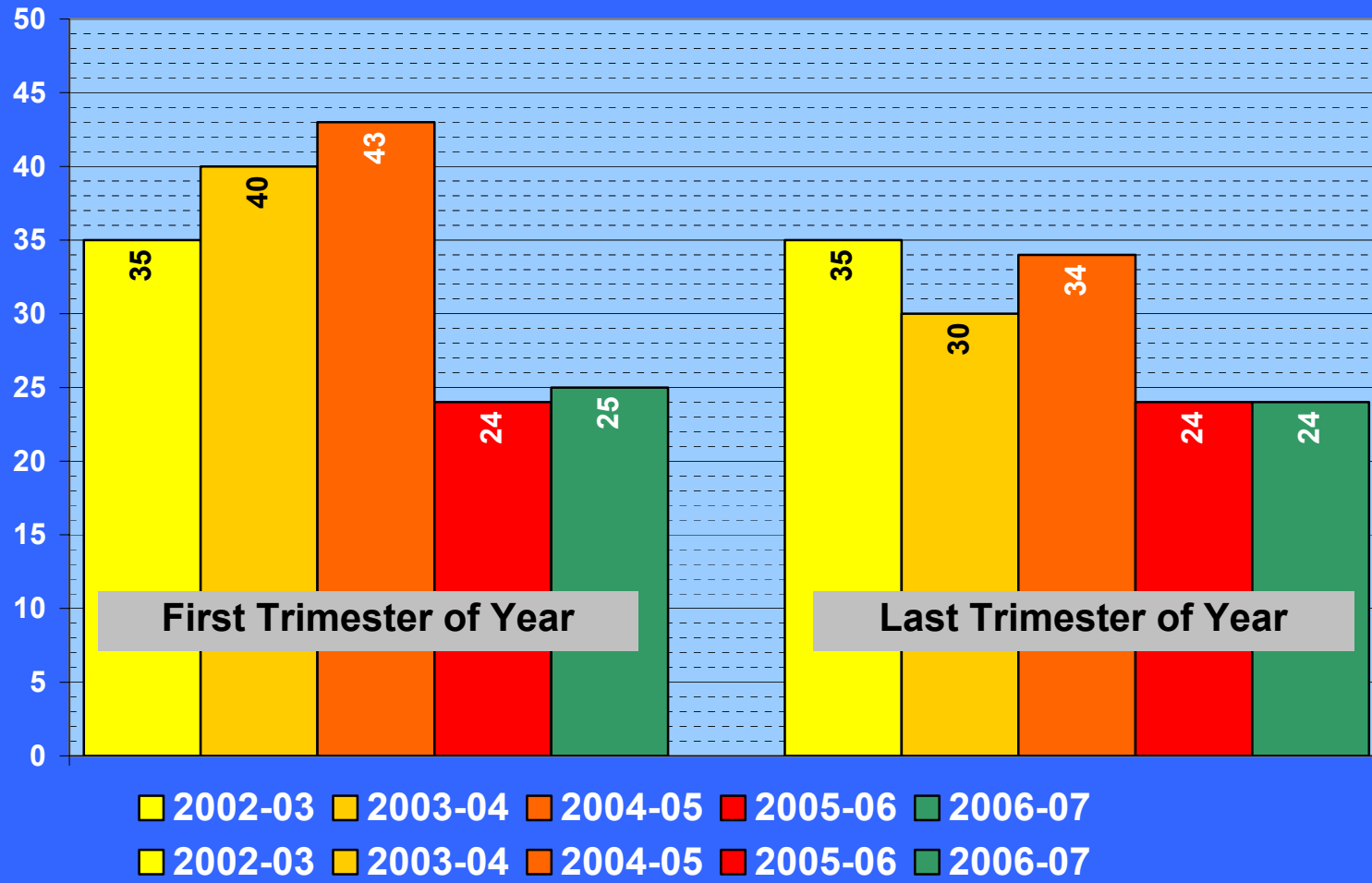

## Students Taking One or More AP Courses During Year



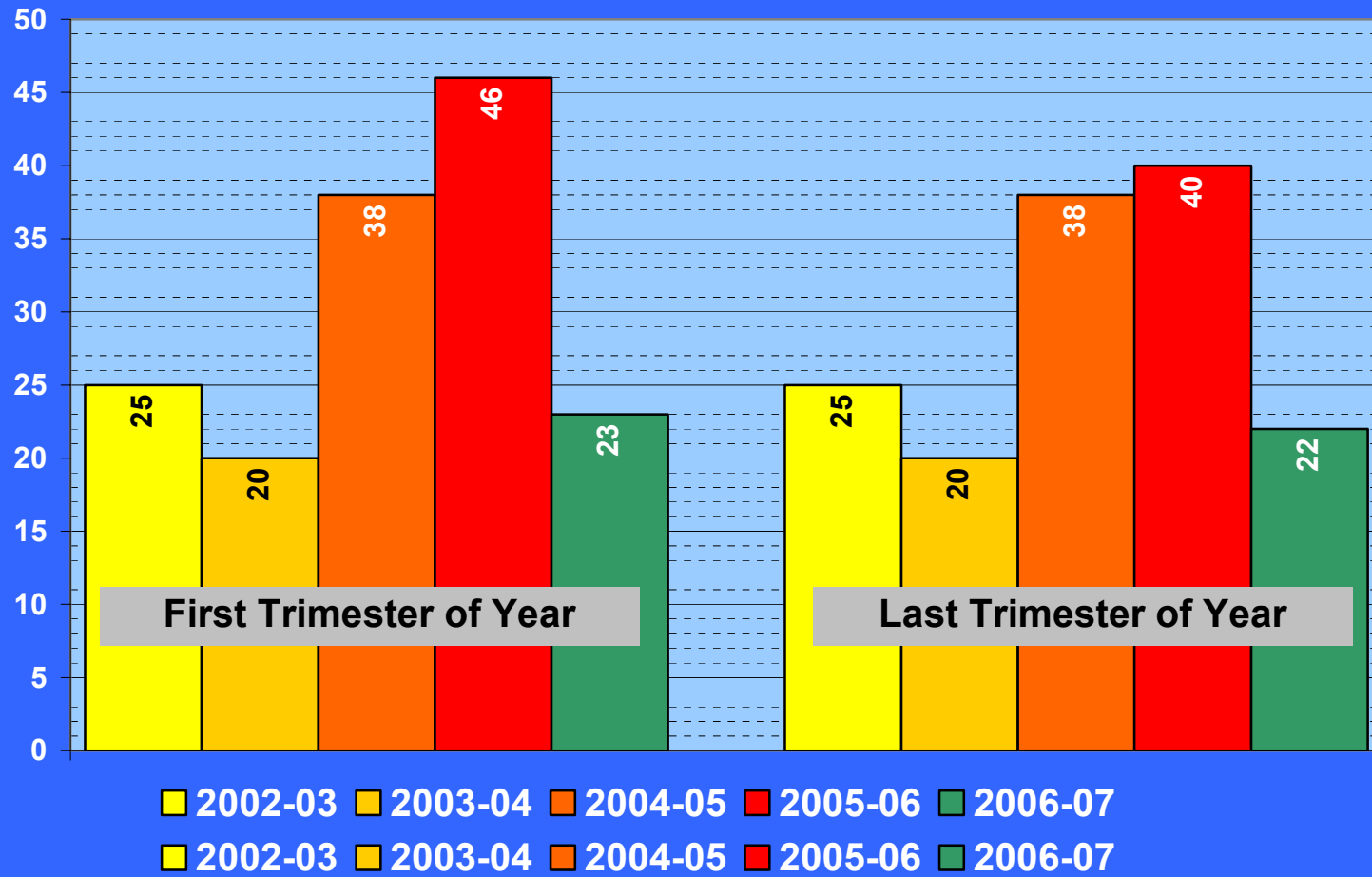

## Enrollment in AP History



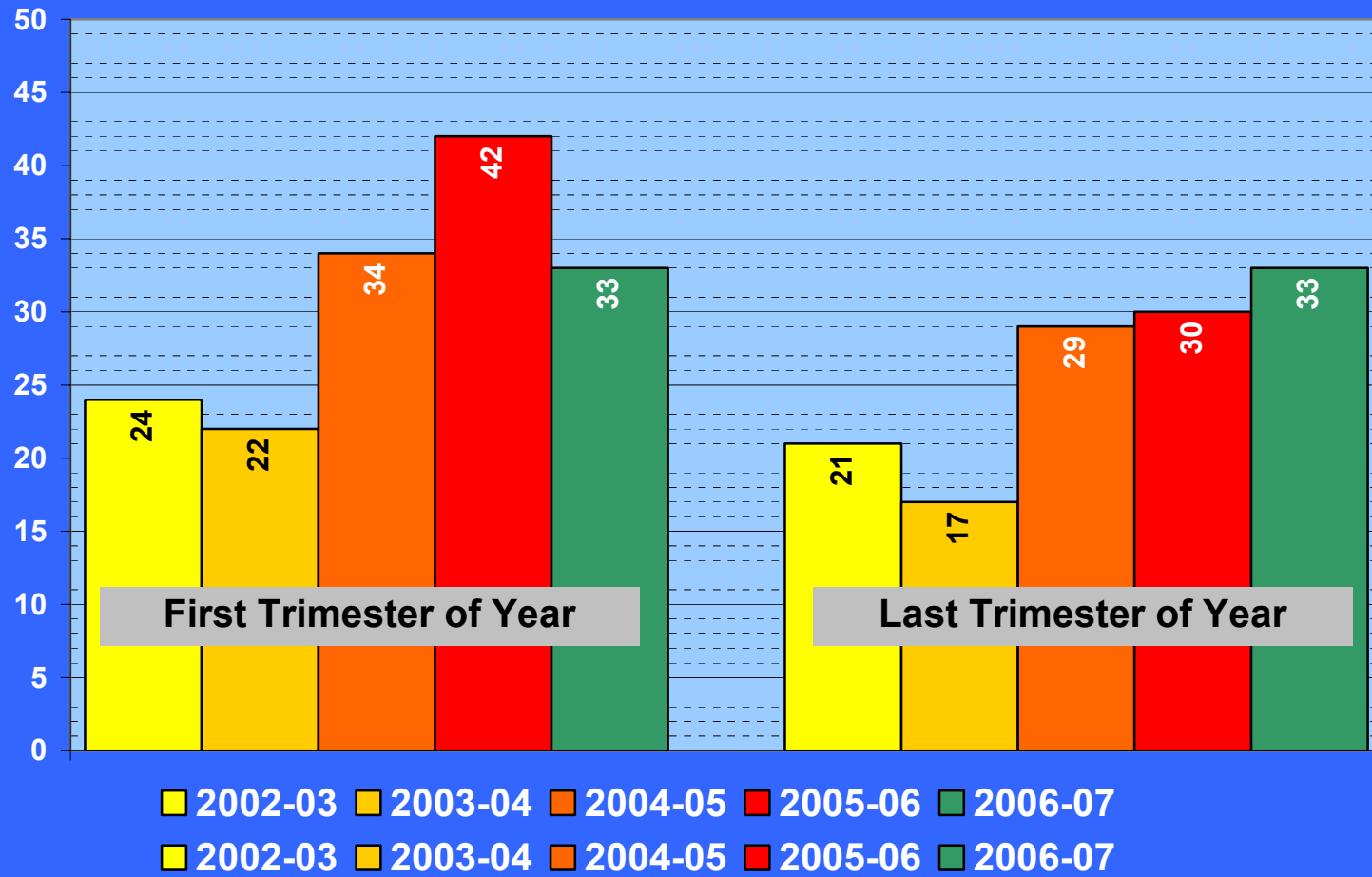

## Enrollment in AP Government



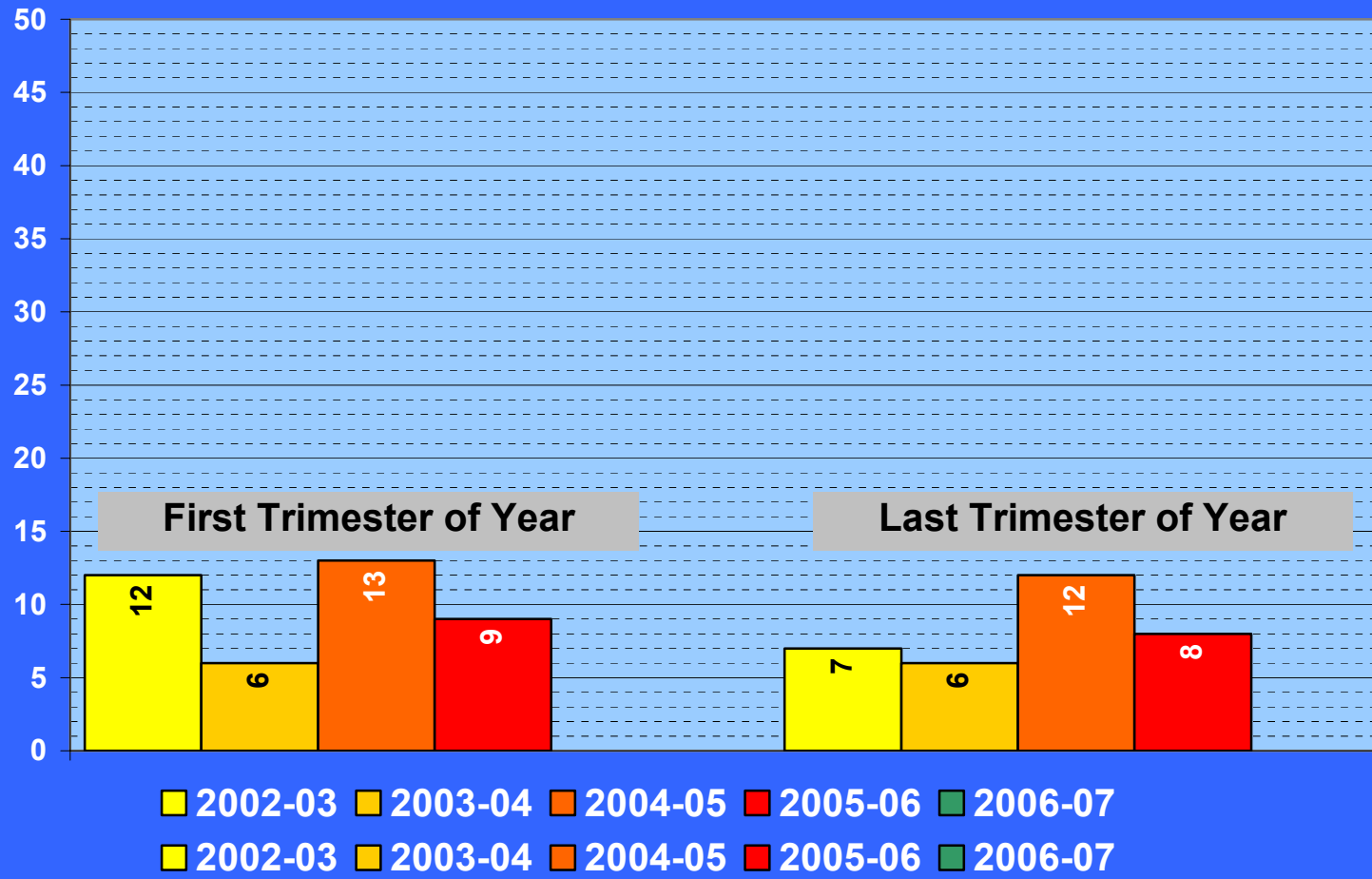

## Enrollment in AP Calculus



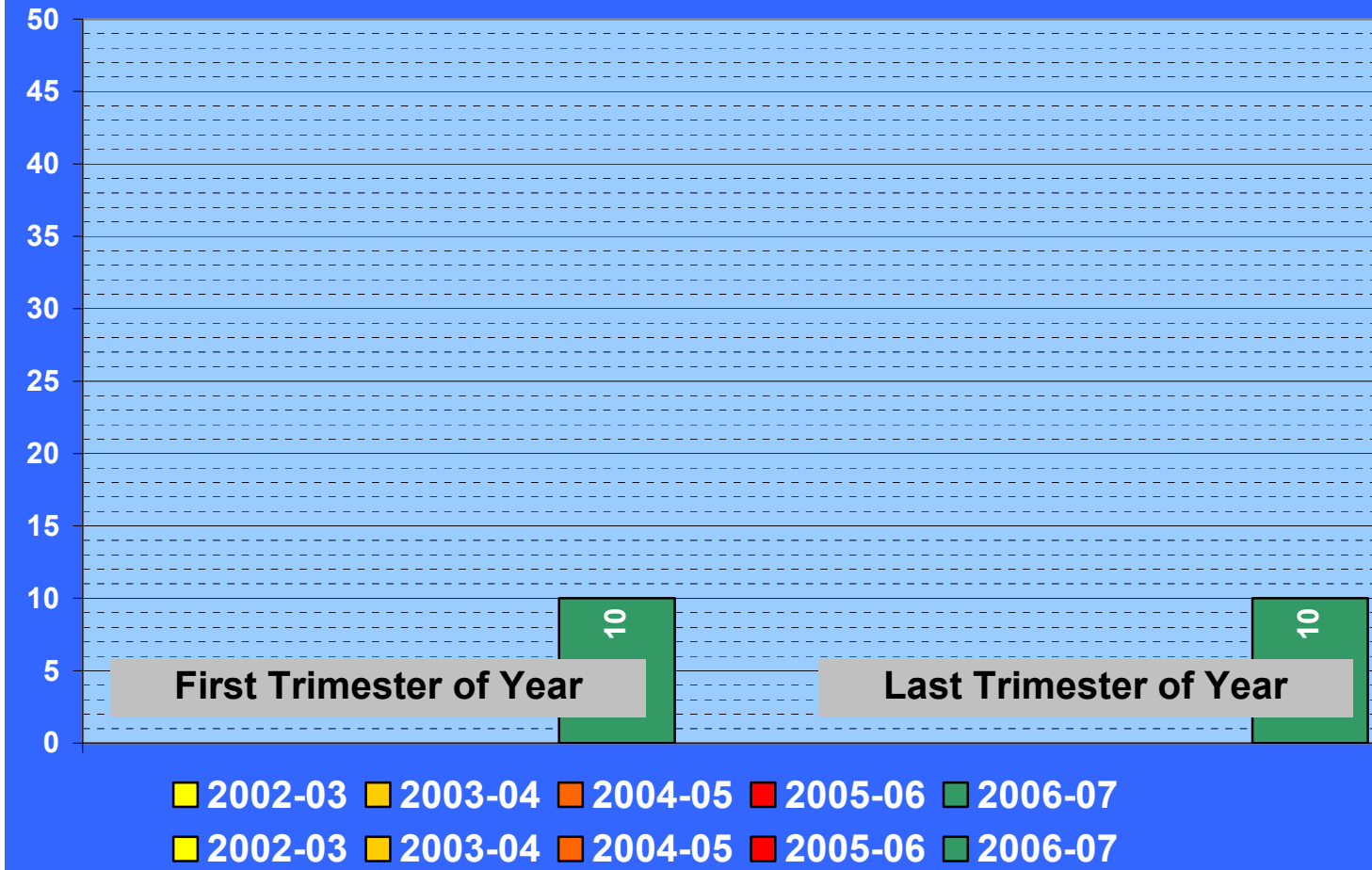

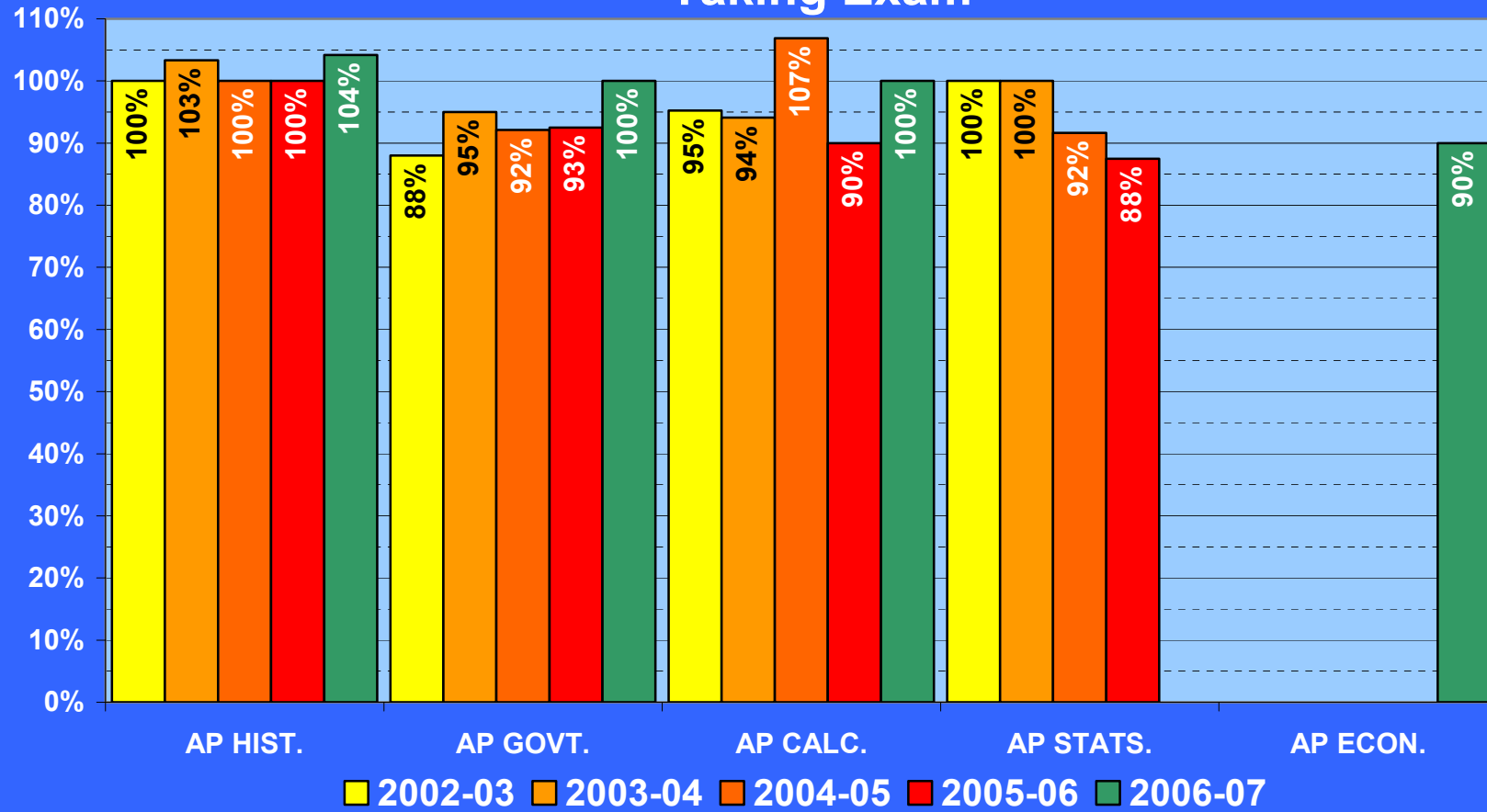

## Enrollment in AP Economics



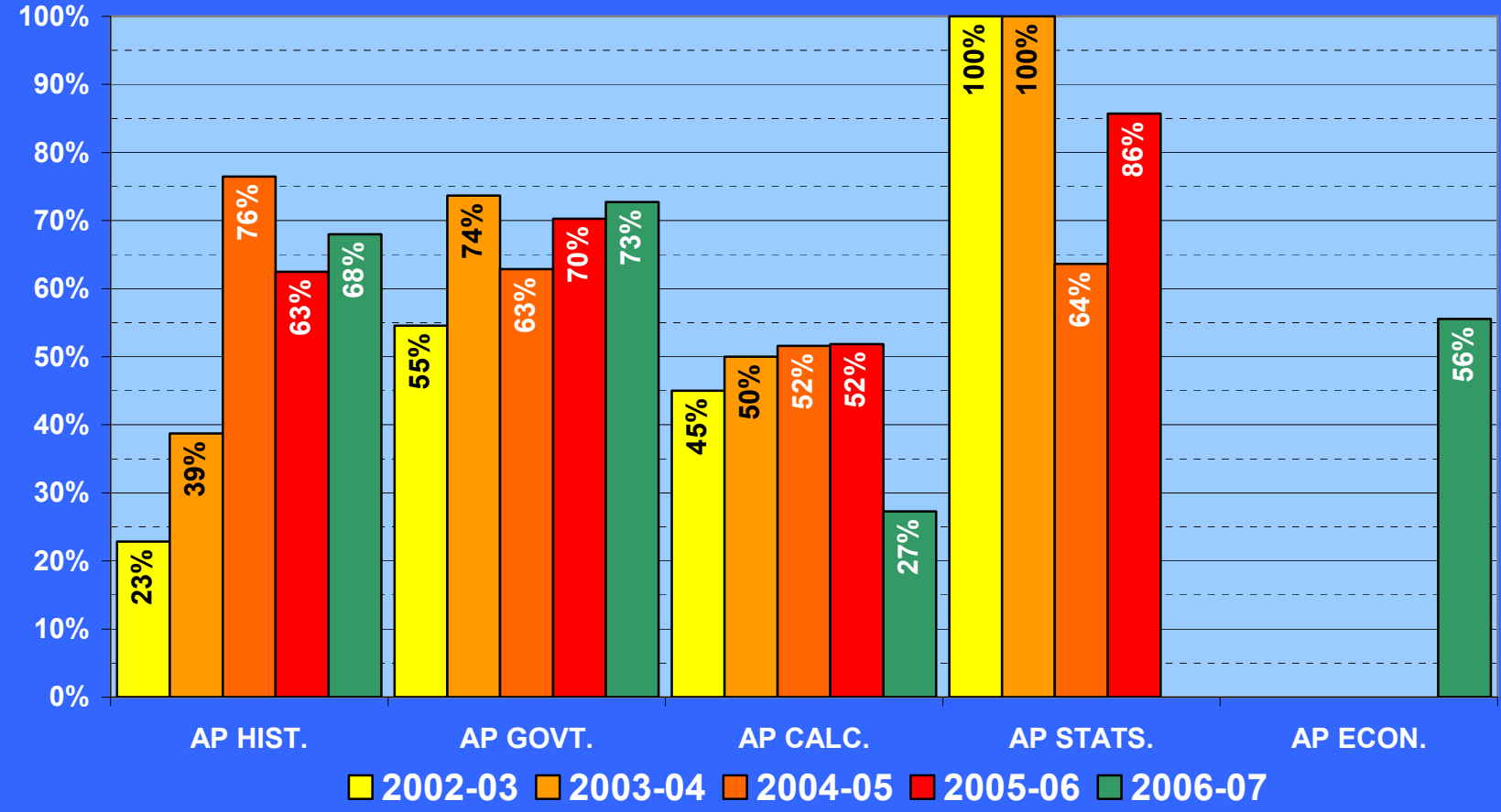

## Percent of AP Students Enrolled Last Trimester of Year Taking Exam



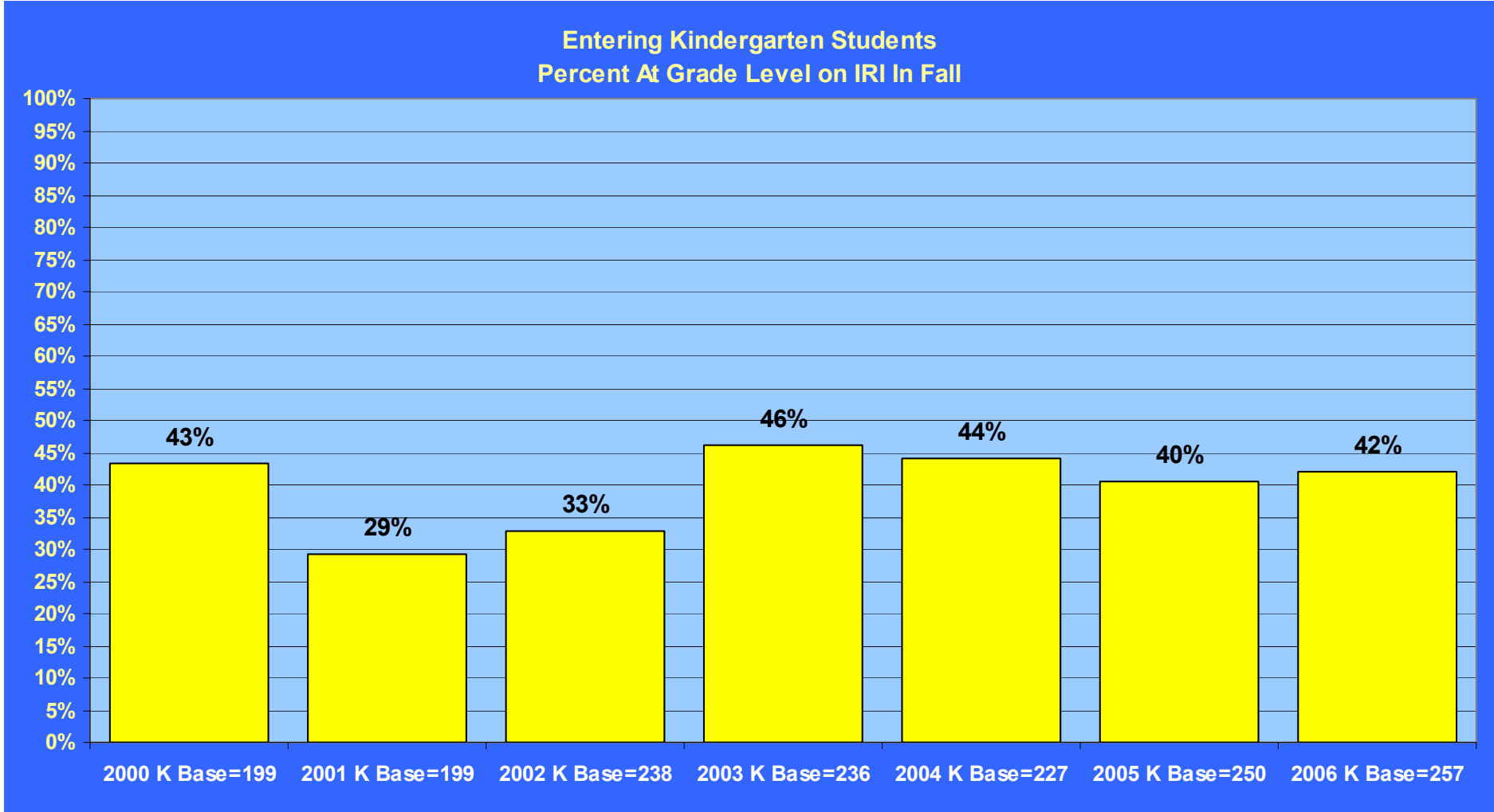

## Percent of AP Students Passing Exam (Score of 3 or Better)



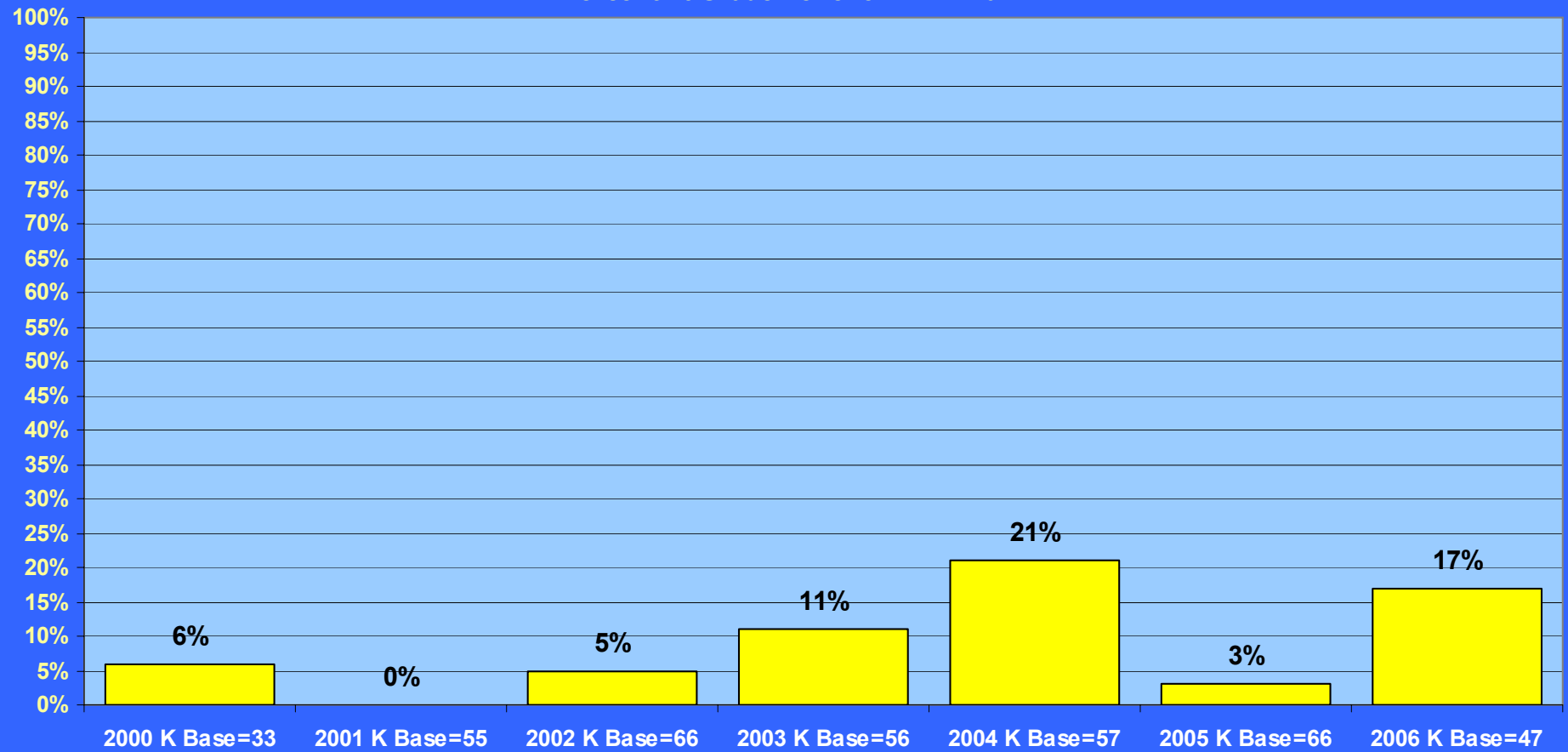

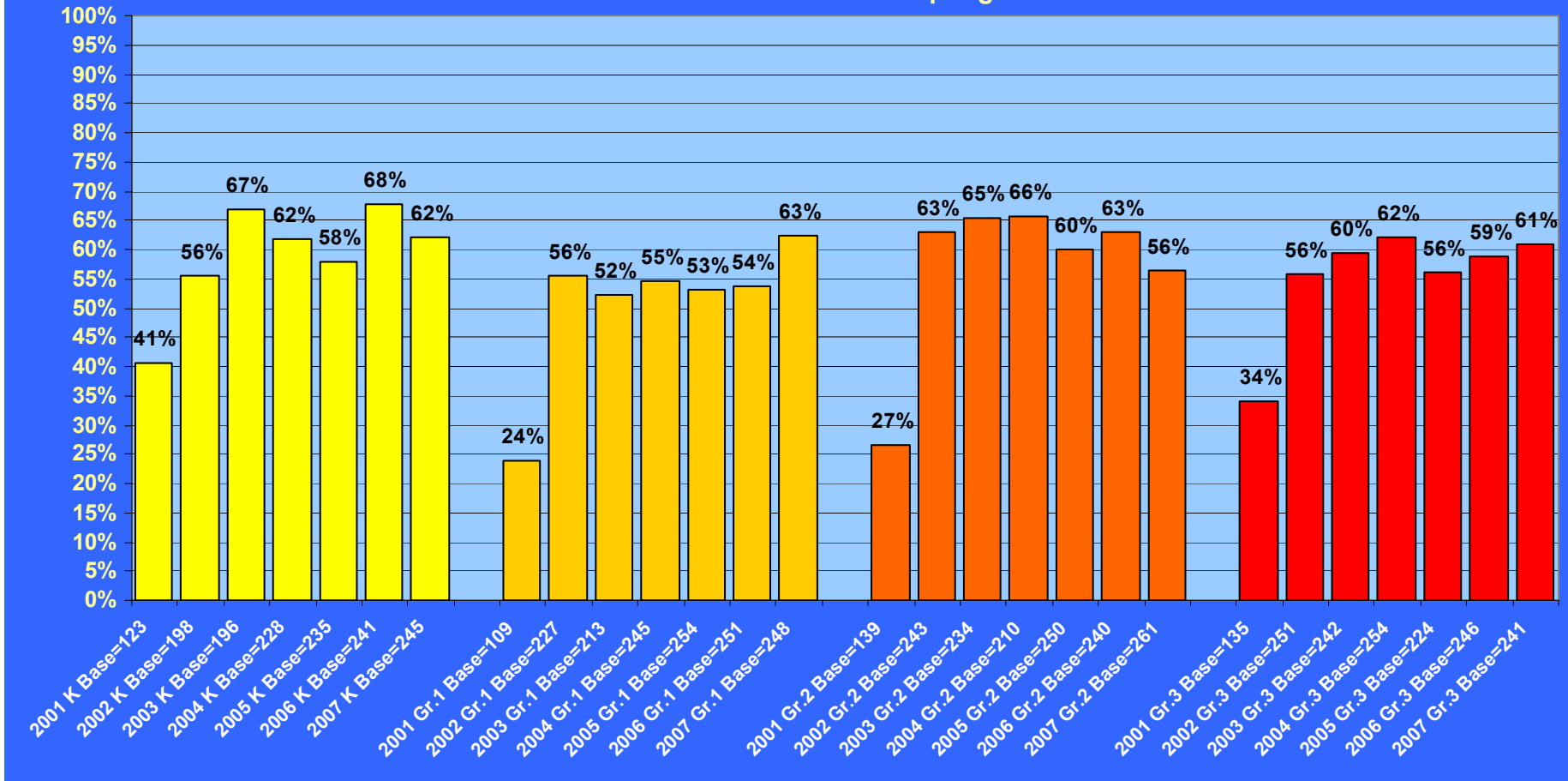
Entering Kindergarten LEP Students

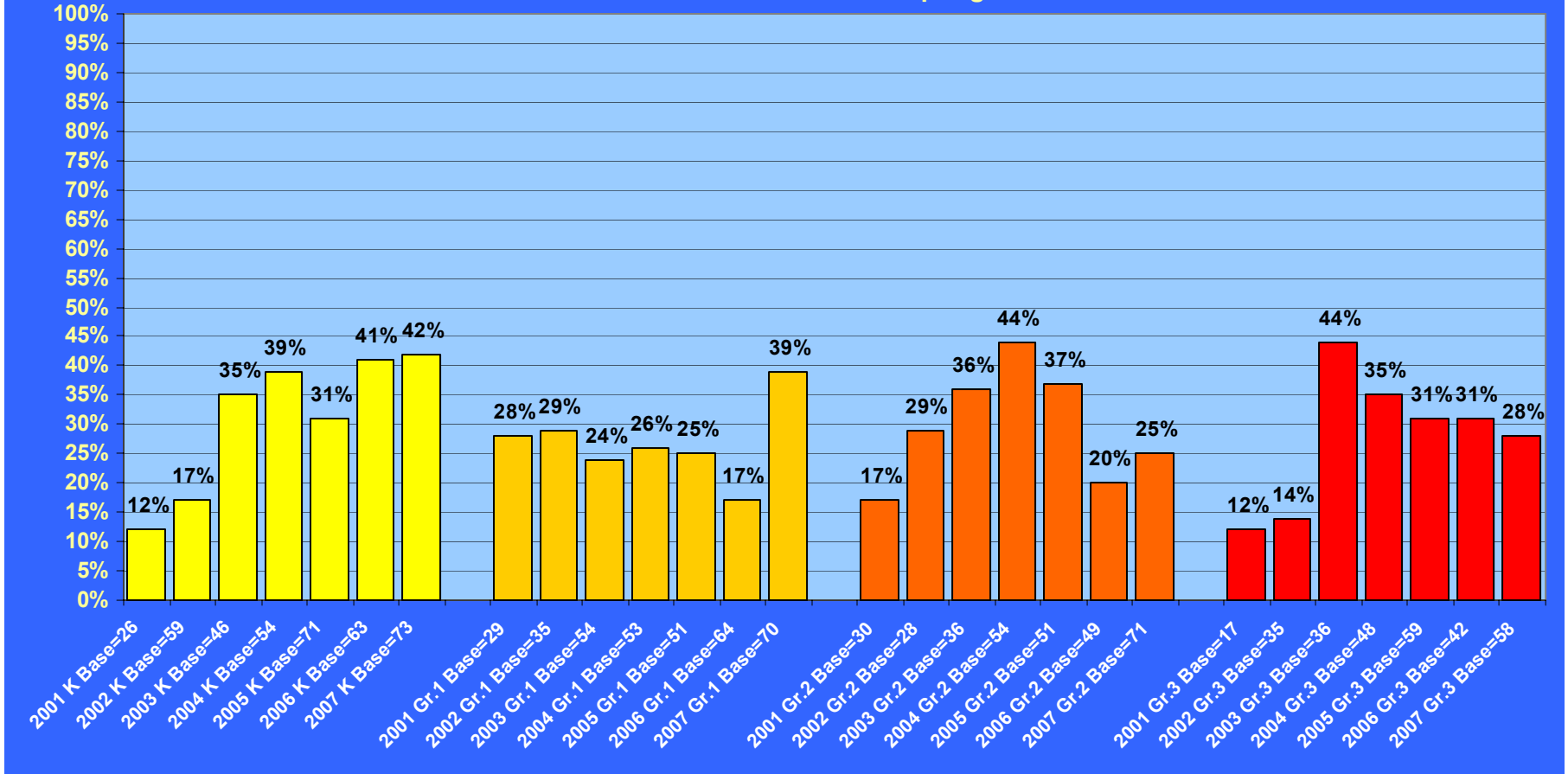
### IRI Total Students Percent At Grade Level In Spring

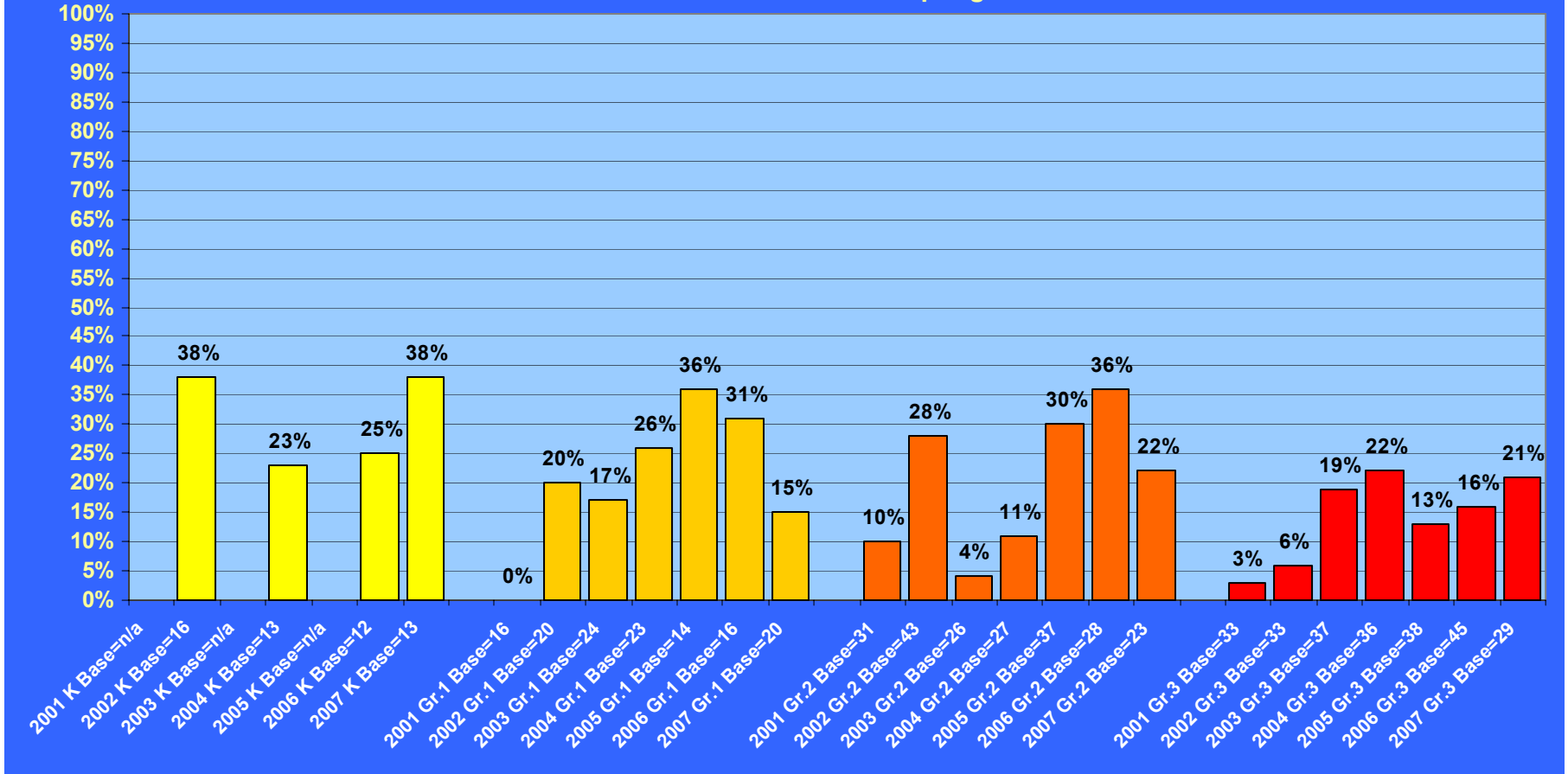
### IRI LEP Students Percent At Grade Level In Spring

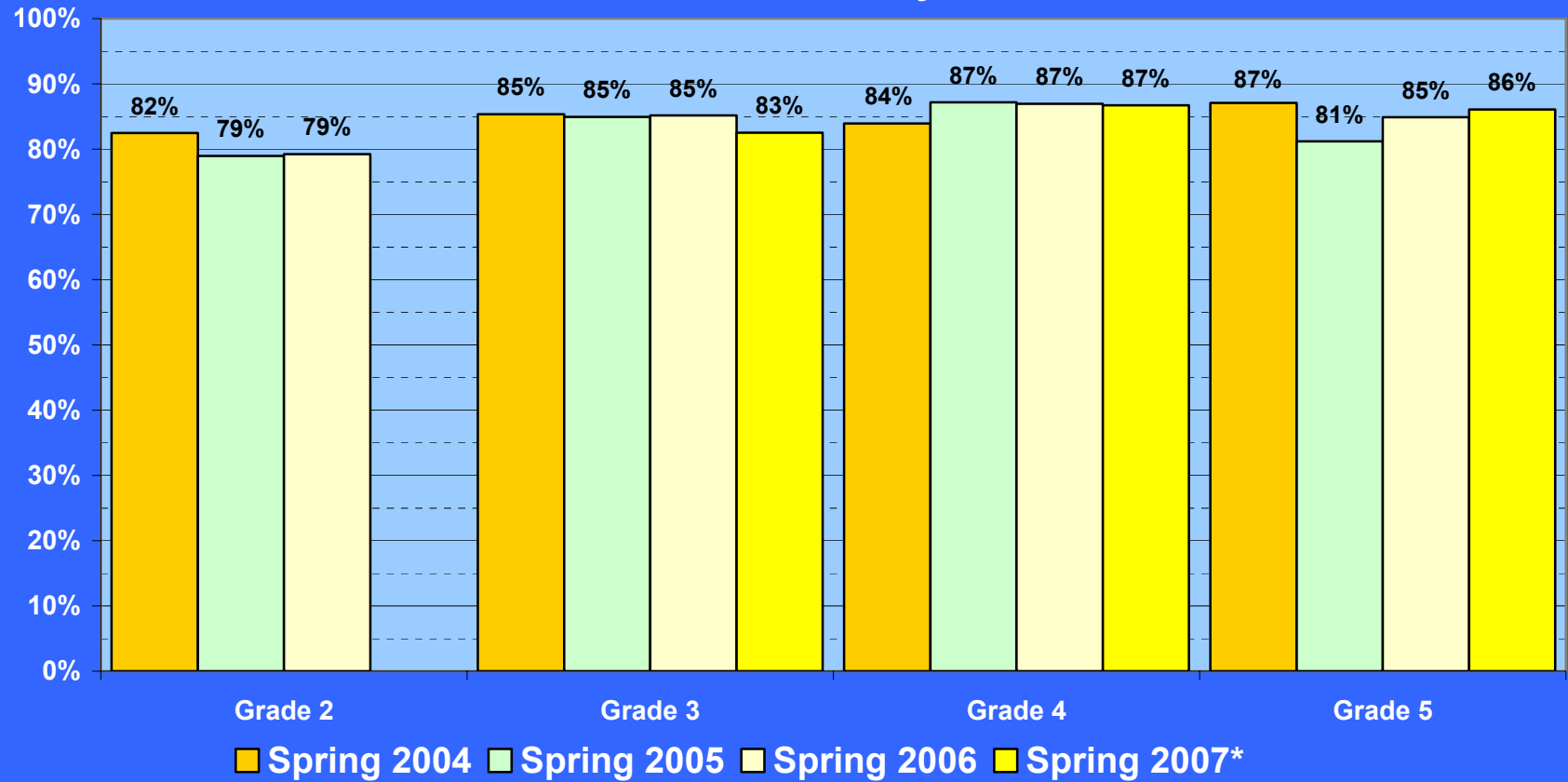
### IRI Special Education Students Percent At Grade Level In Spring

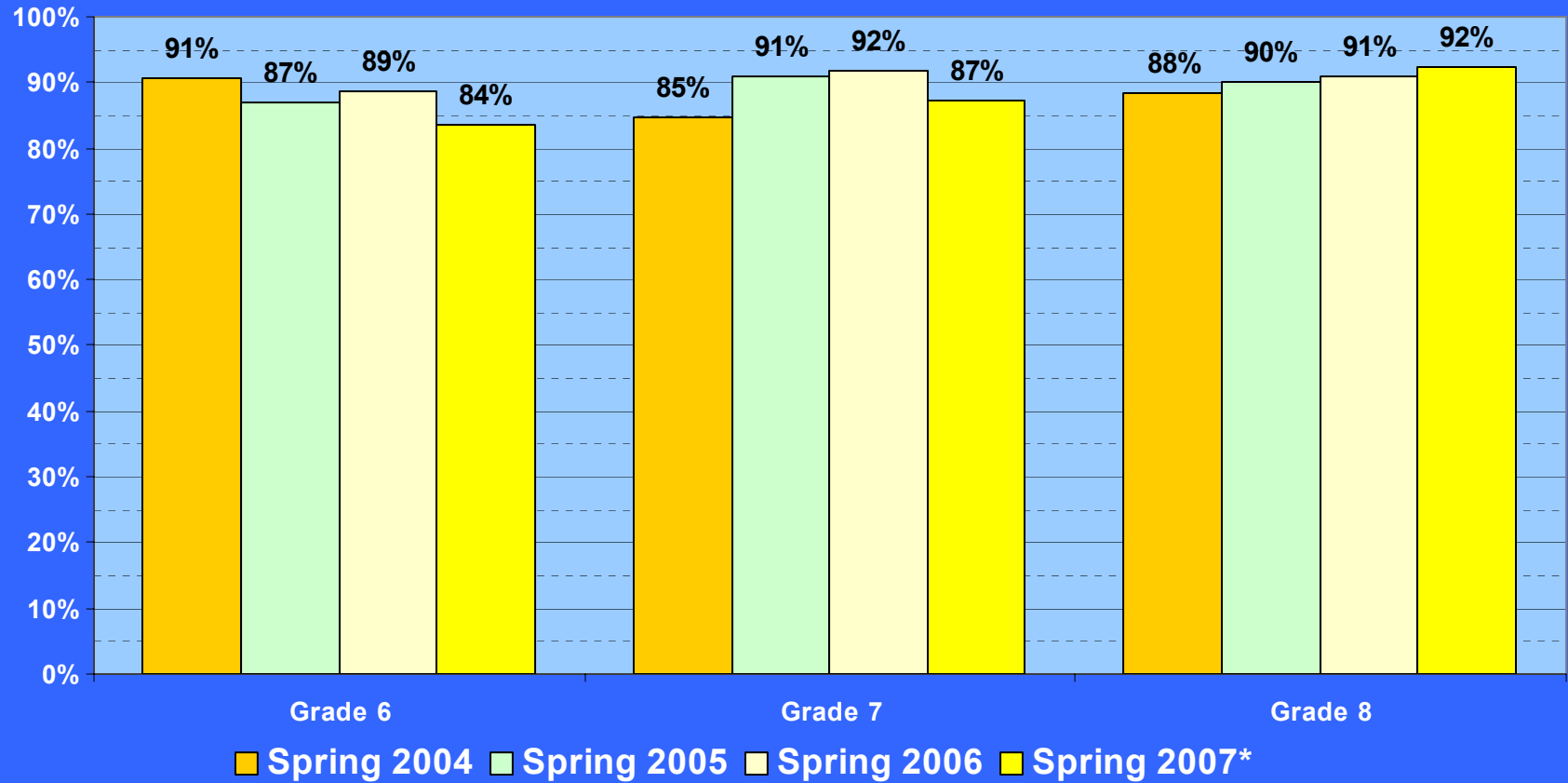

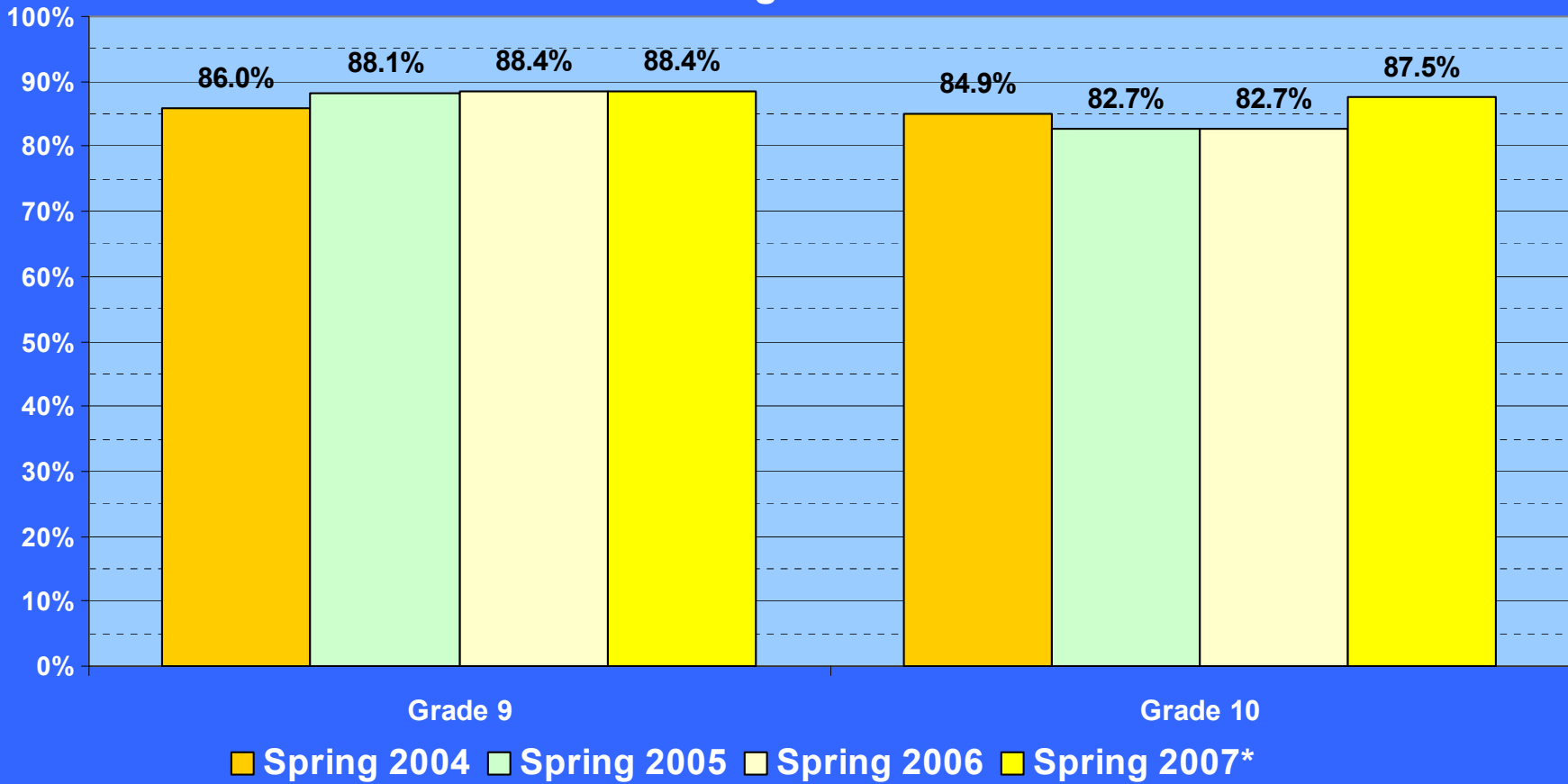
## Reading ISAT Proficient or Better Middle School

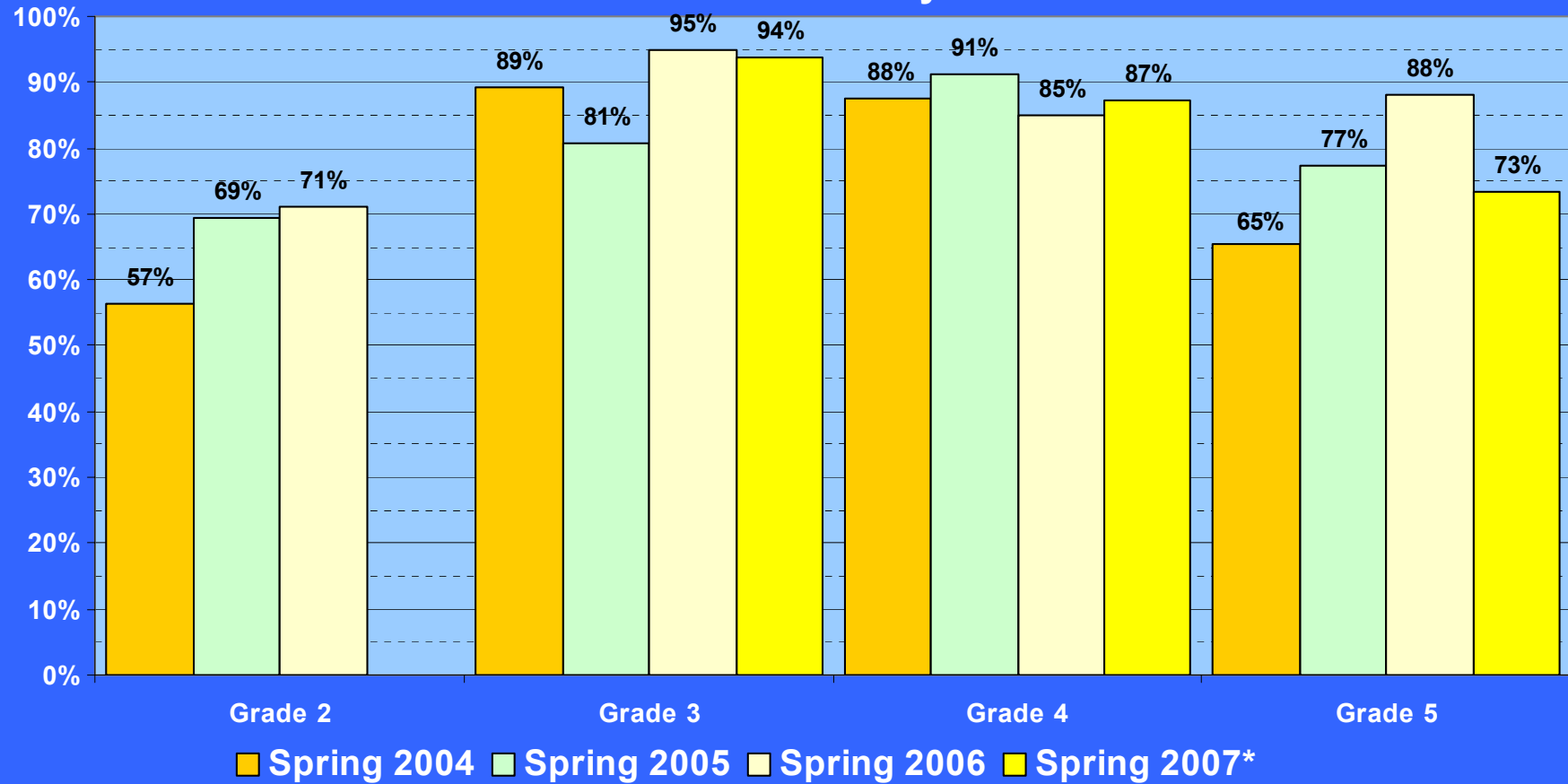
## Reading ISAT Proficient or Better High School

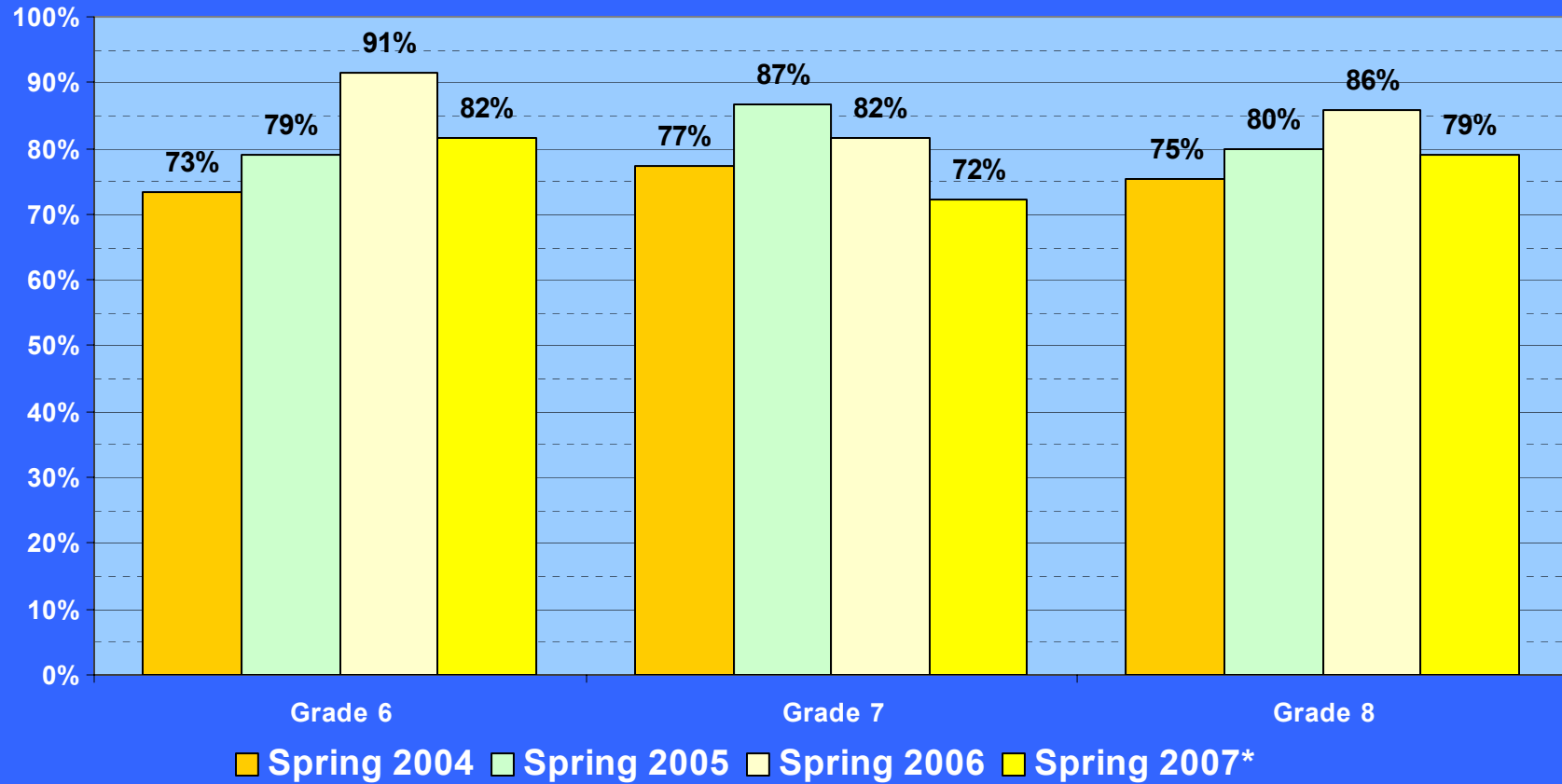
## Mathematics ISAT Proficient or Better Elementary

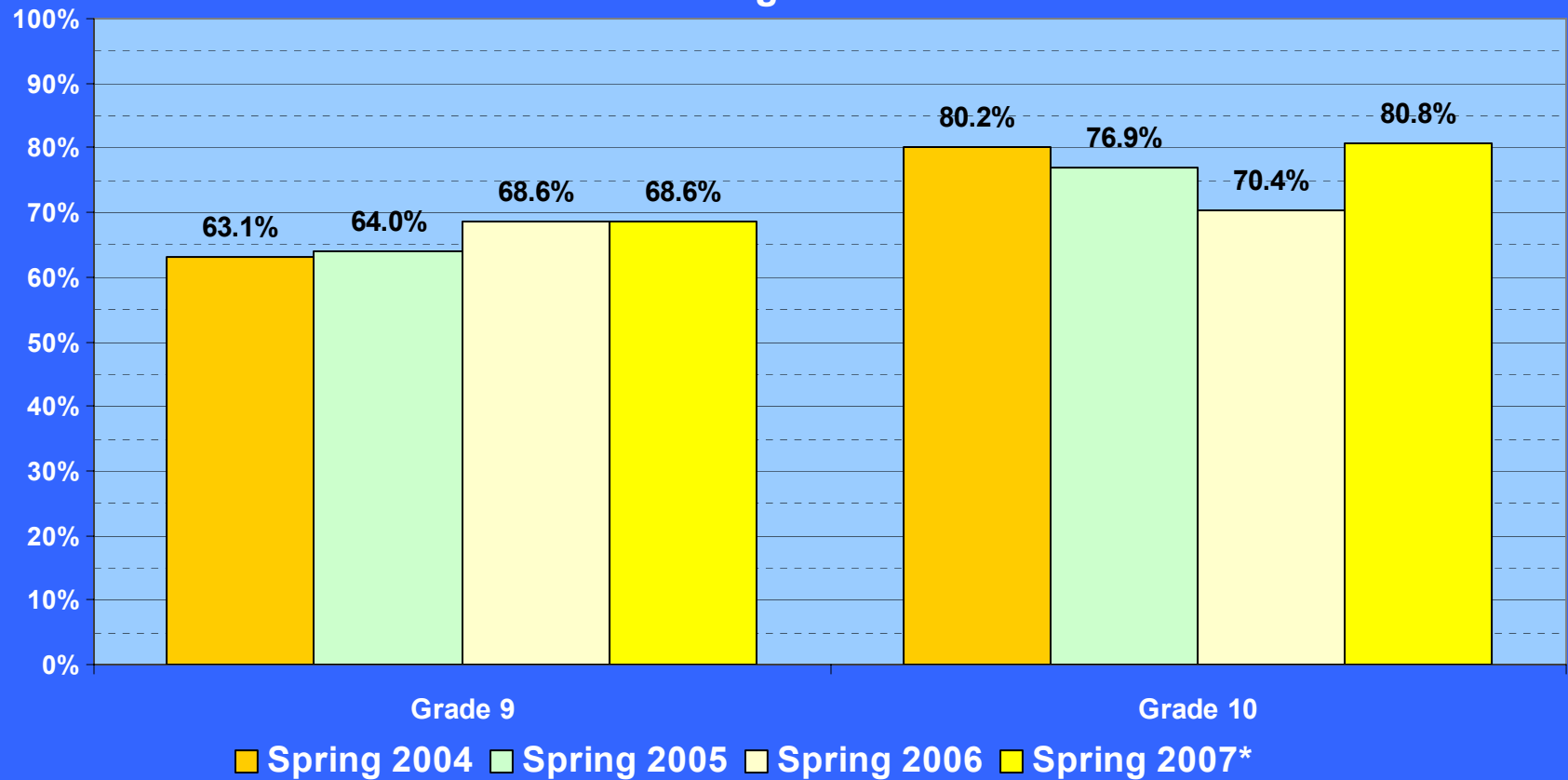
## Mathematics ISAT Proficient or Better Middle School

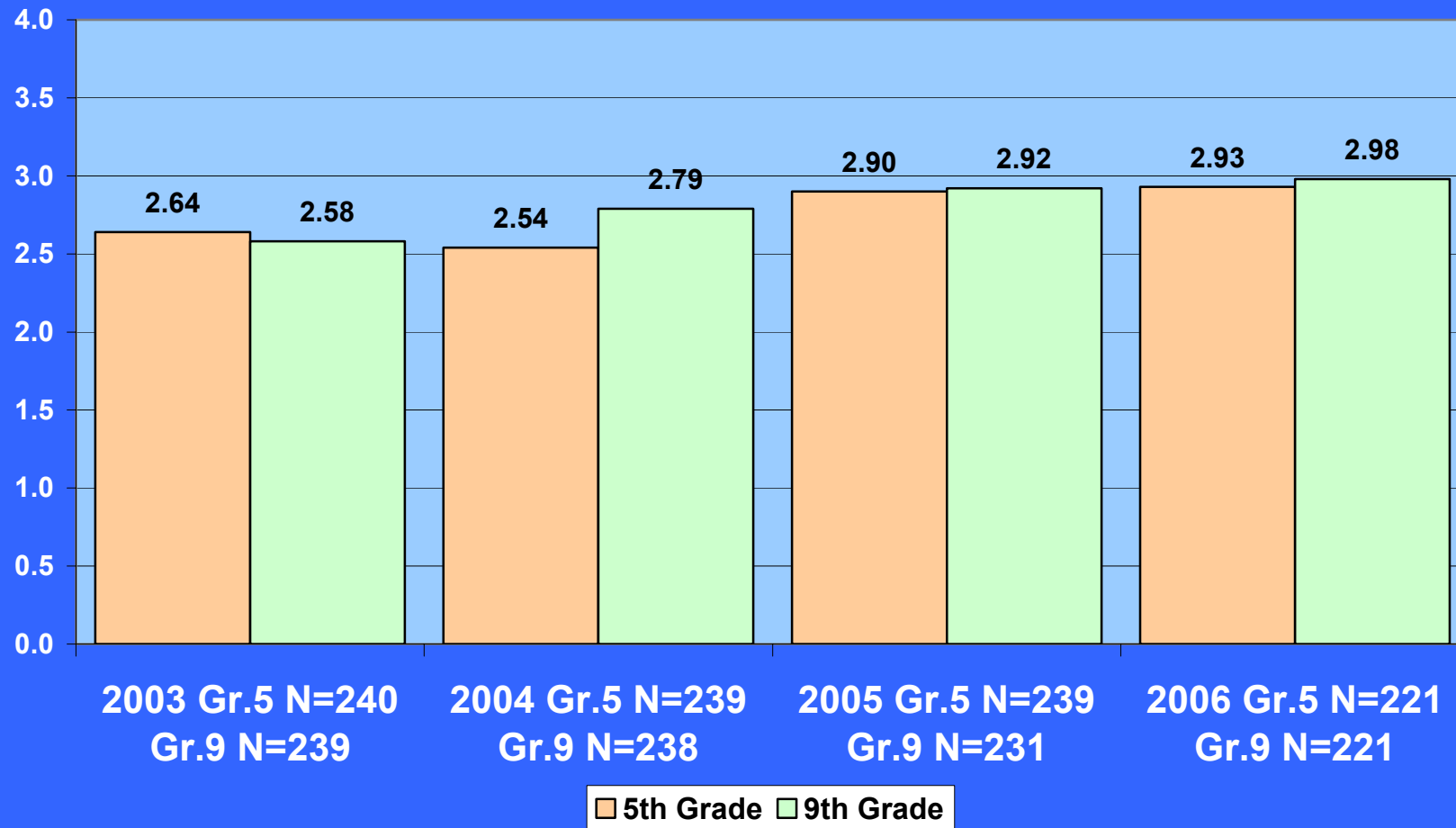
## Mathematics ISAT Proficient or Better High School

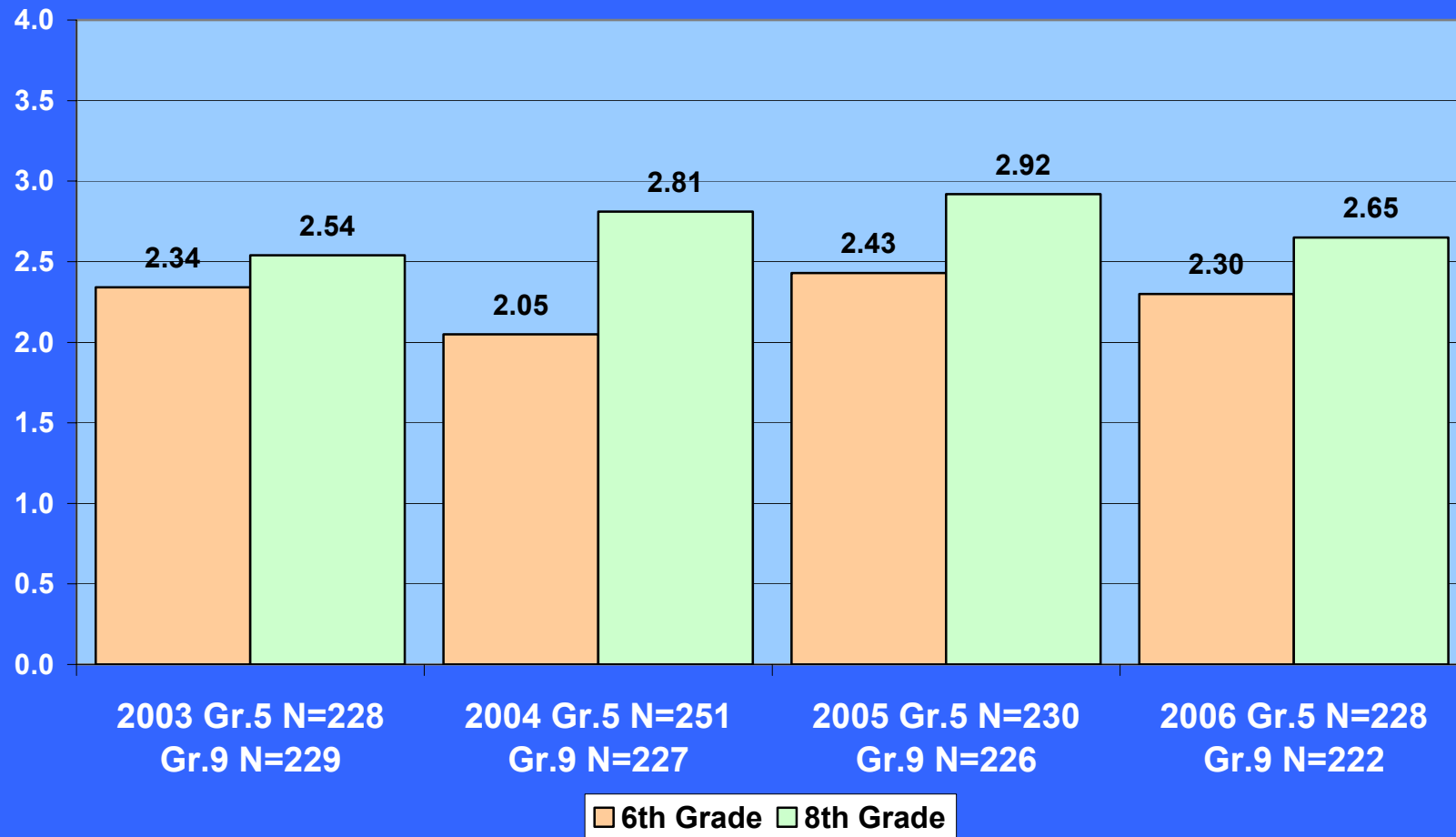
