### **Possibilities of using the Community Campus as Middle School**

- 1) Move College of Southern Idaho and Blaine County Recreation District from the Community Campus. Would open 13-14 classrooms.
- 2) Move the Sixth Grade back into the Elementary School
- 3) Look at Year around school possibilities
- 4) Move Eighth grade to the Community Campus
- 5) Move new Middle School into Community Campus

### **Pros**

Building already exists

Already owned by the District thus saving approximately \$27 Million

Would allow to move Sixth or Eighth Grade to the Community Campus

### **Cons**

Displaces CSI and likely Head Start

Displaces BCRD

Would lose the trust built up from the last Strategic Plan

Would displace Senior Citizens Programs

Would need to remodel the kitchen area again

Too close to the existing High School

Would only buy about two to three years of growth and would still need a Middle School

By moving eighth grade to Community Campus, would create a mixed company and more than likely hurt BCRD programs.

Community would lose a valuable asset in the Community Campus
