## Policies & Procedures

<p><b>Attendance</b>-Attendance and participation are required. If you are absent, you are responsible to find out what work you have missed. You have the same amount of days given to complete the work as originally assigned. After that, the late policy will be enforced.</p>	<p><b>Honesty</b>-Cheating and plagiarism will not be tolerated in any form. Any assignment that is proven to be the work of anyone other than the student will be given a zero to both parties.</p>
<p><b>Late Work</b>-Late work is accepted until your final test grade in the same unit. <i>However, it is best practice to turn in work by its due date.</i> (Practice in class <i>and</i> at home will help you get better grades on your tests and quizzes!!)</p>	<p><b>Homework</b>-Most homework will be assigned if you do not finish your work in class. Play some math games at home and practice your facts!</p>
<p><b>Grading</b>-Grades will be updated in Skyward on a weekly basis. It is your responsibility to check that your grades match what is entered electronically. Late work will be entered when the teacher gets to it. Do not repeatedly ask for missing assignments to be updated if you did not take the time to turn it in on time.</p>	<p><b>Preparation</b>-Students are expected to be prepared for class each day. That means:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• You have materials: your binder and math notebook every day (pencils &amp; erasers too)</li><li>• You completed any unfinished work.</li><li>• You start working on the Warm Ups when the bell rings as the teacher takes attendance.</li></ul>

2. Don't be afraid to ask for help! Ask the teacher or a responsible classmate.
3. Come in before school.
