- A. Rules

- 3. <u>Assessments</u> At the end of each unit, you will be given an opportunity to demonstrate that you have mastered the information in the unit. Be creative in showing your mastery of the unit! Sometimes you will be given a format to follow, but other times you will be given the freedom to demonstrate mastery. Demonstrations could include writing, video, presentation, performance, etc.

E. <u>Every Student</u>, <u>Every Assignment</u> - Each student is expected to complete <u>all</u> assignments.
