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Advisory is Wood River High School's opportunity for all students and staff to build healthy relationships and for students to succeed in high school and beyond. Through reflection students will work toward achieving their potential.

## I. Course Description:

## Advisory:

- Promotes academic success and healthy life choices
- Is a formal structure for monitoring student progress
- Prepares students for college and career
- Supports students with their required 10th Grade Personal Projects
- Builds healthy social, emotional and behavioral skills
- Provides students with a teacher who can offer mentorship and support throughout their high school careers
- Connects students with each other, with adults, with the school and with the community through fun and engaging interactions
- Fosters a positive school culture

The Advisory lessons for 10th grade will focus on self-identity and connection. This theme allows students to explore who they are becoming and how it connects to those around them and future plans.

## II. Methods of Assessment/Grading Policy:

The Pass/Fail grades for Advisory will be determined by the following criteria:

- 10 points for participation (completion of lesson activity) for the full 60 minute period
- 5 points for participation in the full 30 minute period
- 0 points for absences\* or non-participation
- No partial points allowed

\*As per district policy, students can make up missed lesson activity or specified makeup activity for excused absences within two Advisory periods.
