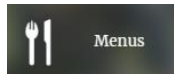




School Lunch – FAQs

What is for lunch?

What does lunch cost this school year?

Elementary - \$3.05

Middle School - \$3.40

High School - \$3.65

2nd Student Lunch/Adult Lunch - \$4.70

Breakfast for Student - \$1.55

2nd Student Breakfast / Adult Breakfast - \$2.65

The first meal for a student is charged at the student rate. If a student has seconds, the meal is charged at the full price. A La Carte items are available at a few of our campuses and each item is individually priced. Please discuss the option to have a la carte items and second meals with your child(ren).

How do I check my child's lunch account?

You can check your child's lunch account from PowerSchool. If you are using the PowerSchool app, you can click on the Gear icon and select to show Meal Balance. When logging into PowerSchool from a web browser, click on Balances.

Where is the money from my Skyward lunch account?

How do I add money to my child's lunch account?

PowerSchool manages lunch accounts by student and not by household. You will need to add money to each child's account.

There are 3 ways to add money or make a payment:

1. Credit Card or ECheck payment from PowerSchool (log in from a web browser)
2. Bring cash or check to your school
3. Cash, check, or credit card are accepted at the District Office – 118 W Bullion, Hailey
