WHO IS ELIGIBLE FOR THE BUS TRANSPORTATION? Elementary students who live more than .5 miles from school. Middle and high school students who live more than .75 miles from school.

WHY? The State of Idaho reimburses schools for bus transportation for students who live more than 1.5 miles away from school. Blaine County School District goes above and beyond the state reimbursement while continuing to look for efficiencies in our systems and ways to improve our services.

One Pick-Up and Drop-Off Location

Our responsibility is to transport students to and from school. We will provide bus transportation to one fixed pick-up location in the morning and one fixed drop-off location in the afternoon. The morning and afternoon locations may be two different locations but they will remain the same locations throughout the school year. Why? We have to budget and plan our school routes at the beginning of each year and we cannot provide individual transportation plans for each student for their activities before and after school. Multiple seats on different buses for individual students requires additional buses and bus drivers.
