

## SCHOOL HEALTH OFFICE Sent Home Note & Return to School Criteria

No COVID-19 test or no confirmed result	Symptoms <i>with</i> alternate explanation (strep, influenza, etc. as determined by a provider)	no fever for 24 hours (w/o use of medicine) AND
		other symptoms have resolved <b>AND</b>
		note from provider stating the individual has an alternate diagnosis
	Symptoms <b>without</b> alternate explanation	no fever for 24 hours (w/o use of medicine) AND
		other symptoms have improved <b>AND</b>
		10 days since first symptoms
Negative COVID-19 test result	With symptoms	no fever for 24 hours (w/o use of medicine) AND
		other symptoms have improved
	Without Symptoms	No known exposure to positive case, attend school <b>OR</b>
		Known exposure: Quarantine for 14 days (safest) or 7 days (With testing)
Positive COVID-19 test result	With symptoms	no fever for 24 hours (w/o use of medicine)AND
		other symptoms have improved <b>AND</b>
		10 days since first symptoms
	Without symptoms	10 days since date positive test taken AND
		continue to have no symptoms
		If symptoms develop, 10 days since first symptoms develop
Close Contact to Positive Case in an Instructional Setting only.	Without Mask	After 14-Day Quarantine (Safest) from exposure <b>OR</b>
		After 10-Day Quarantine, Monitor & Socal Distance <b>OR</b>
		After 7-Day Quarantine from exposure, with a negative test taken after 5 days of quarantine
	With Mask	Self Monitor: Continue Proper Handwashing, Mask Wearing and Social Distance when possible
Close Contact to Positive Case (non-instructional setting)	Without symptoms	After 14-Day Quarantine (Safest) from exposure <b>OR</b>
		After 10-Day Quarantine, Monitor & Socal Distance <b>OR</b>
		After 7-Day Quarantine from exposure, with a negative test taken after 5 days of quarantine
Fully Vaccinated Individuals	Full Vaccinated= ≥2 weeks following receipt of the second dose in a 2-dose series or ≥2 weeks following receipt of one dose of a single-dose vaccine	If you meet all the following criteria you do NOT need to quarantine.  • Are fully vaccinated  • Have remained asymptomatic since the current COVID-19 exposure
		Recommended: Get tested after 3-5 days from exposure, mask and socially distance for 14 days from exposure.

These guidelines may be subject to change based on federal, state, or local guidance; advice from district health partners; or degree of community transmission.
