Dear Parents,

Welcome to the 2019-2020 school year at Bellevue Elementary School. We are expecting a terrific year ahead! Below are a few pieces of information for you to start the school year with:

Planner -

• Your child will be using a spiral-bound planner as a means of organization and communication. Please review and sign this planner *each day* for homework or reminders of upcoming information. Students' homework folder (yellow pocket folder) is placed in the planner and holds work needed to be completed. Your signature/initials in the planner space confirm that you oversaw homework completion or read reminders.

Is there a significant amount of homework in my 4th grade classroom? Not typically; however, what I do encourage for continued growth is:

- <u>Reading library book (20 minutes minimum)</u>. This can be done independently and/or with you or other family member.
- Practicing <u>math facts</u> (+, -, x, ÷) (10-15 min.). Flash cards or online sites (see my web site for links) are great ways to practice. Completing any assigned homework.
- Practicing words on weekly spelling list

Snack -

• I encourage students to bring a <u>small, healthy snack</u> to eat such as sliced fruits, vegetables, cheese, or whole grain snacks (no chips or desserts nor is there time to peel oranges or eat a whole apple). There is only 5 minutes for Snack, so think healthy but quick!
