HEMINGWAY WINTERSPORTS PROGRAM 2017

First through fifth grade students at Hemingway will again have an opportunity to participate in our supervised ski/snowboard/skate/snowshoe program. The following will outline the details of this program which allows all students, from **beginning to advanced abilities**, to participate at no cost.

Who and Where:

Skiers:

- ALL 1st graders and 2nd 5th grade beginning skiers will ski Dollar Mountain.
- 2nd 5th grade students able to ski Baldy competently may ski Baldy.

SVSEF Devo Ski Team Members:

- SVSEF Devo team will have coaches available on ski days. Team members may choose to ski with their coaches. Sign up as a **Baldy skier** on the Purple form and circle "**Devo Team**".
- Snowboard team members may sign up and board with the Hemingway program. SVSEF snowboard coaches will NOT be available.
- Members of teams who train on ski days (Thursdays) should <u>NOT</u> sign up for the program.

Ice Skaters:

• 1st - 5th Graders skate at the Sun Valley Ice Rink (all levels of skaters).

Nordic Skiers and Snowshoers, 3rd - 5th grade ONLY:

• Nordic Skiers will ski at Sun Valley Nordic Center (all levels of skiers). Snowshoers will hike on school property (Atkinson's Park). Snowshoeing is limited to 20 students.

Boarders:

• **2nd - 5th grade students with snowboards** may snowboard on Dollar or Baldy according to their ability. *Snow boarders must be experienced.* **No beginners please.** Your 1st grader will be allowed to snowboard ONLY if you volunteer in our program on Dollar.

When:

- 4 Thursdays; January 12, 19, 26, and February 2.
- **Baldy** skier/boarder bus will leave school by 1:15. They will ski until 4:00.
- **Dollar** skier/boarder bus will leave school by 1:30. They will ski until 4:00. We return to the school around **4:30.** Parents are responsible for making arrangements to pick up their children at this time. Students may also be picked up at River Run or Dollar at **4:00.**
- **Nordic Skiers and Ice Skaters** will leave school at 12:45 and ski until 2:00 These students and **Snowshoers** will arrive back at school in time to ride their regular buses home.

Cost: DAILY SKI TICKETS ARE FREE. MEDICAL OR ACCIDENT INSURANCE IS REQUIRED.

Equipment:

Students must provide their own skis, snowboards, poles, and boots. These items should be checked for proper fit and adjustment. Please *mark all equipment with student's name*. Skates and Snowshoes will be provided for student use.

Scholarships for Alpine Ski Equipment:

Scholarships are limited and a \$10 copay is required. Please apply only if your child would not be able to ski without one. These are available based on need. Please contact Principal Don Haisley in writing before, Monday, Dec. 5th. To be considered for a scholarship you need to meet

all deadlines. We are not able to provide snowboards through scholarship.

KEEP THIS SHEET FOR YOUR REFERENCE IN ORDER TO MAXIMIZE THE BENEFITS OF OUR PROGRAM WE HAVE SET UP THE FOLLOWING GUIDELINES:

Personal Commitment:

- Our program's parent volunteers are making a great commitment of time to help our students. For this reason, as well as organizational and safety considerations, we require each child to make a firm commitment to the program and to ski/snowboard weekly. A note, phone call, or email must accompany your child if he/she is unable to participate due to illness or injury but is present at school that day.
- Reminder: <u>Snowboards and skis are NOT allowed on the buses coming to school</u>. You will be responsible for transporting skis and snowboards to school and from school.
- We will transport skis and snowboards to and from the mountains.

Personal Responsibilities:

• All skis, boards, boots, and poles are to be clearly labeled with your child's name. Failure to be responsible for these items more than two times could result in the loss of privileges to participate in this program.

Safety:

- It is absolutely mandatory that there be no skiing/boarding in this program without adult supervision. Any students leaving their group may be asked to leave the program.
- In order to participate in the Wintersports program, your child must be covered by accident and medical insurance.
- At the discretion of an adult supervisor, 2nd 5th grade children who are not capable of skiing/boarding Baldy competently may be asked to ski/snowboard on Dollar until their skills improve.

Transportation Home:

- Students may be picked up from Dollar cabin or River Run at 4:00 or at the school at 4:30.
- Students should know when, where, and by whom they are being picked up.
- Any students not picked up by the time the buses leave will be brought back to school.
- All Ice Skaters, Snowshoers and Nordic skiers will be back at Hemingway in time for regular dismissal.
